

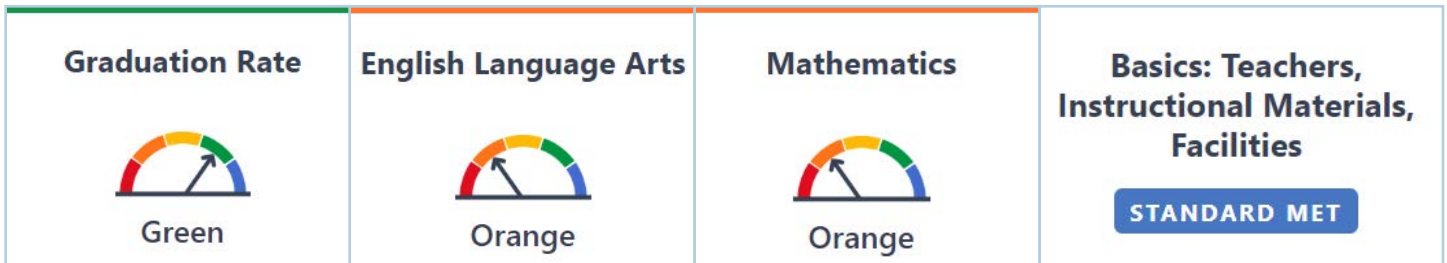
How to View Performance for a School or District on the 2023 Dashboard

1. The California School Dashboard can be accessed at <https://www.caschooldashboard.org/>.
2. To view the results for a school or district, enter the school or district name into the search bar.

3. Once you select a school, its overall performance on state measures will be displayed. If you select a district, its overall performance on both state and local measures will be displayed. Local indicators are only available for districts, county offices of education, and charter schools.



4. Below the performance overview, you will find information about the student population.



5. Following the student population information, you will find more detailed information on each state and local measure. The state and local measures are organized into three areas: Academic Performance, Academic Engagement, and Conditions and Climate.

In the sample card provided, the school received a Green performance level for the Graduation Rate Indicator because in the current year, 93.5 percent of the students graduated, and there was an increase in the graduation rate of 2.1 percentage points from the prior year.

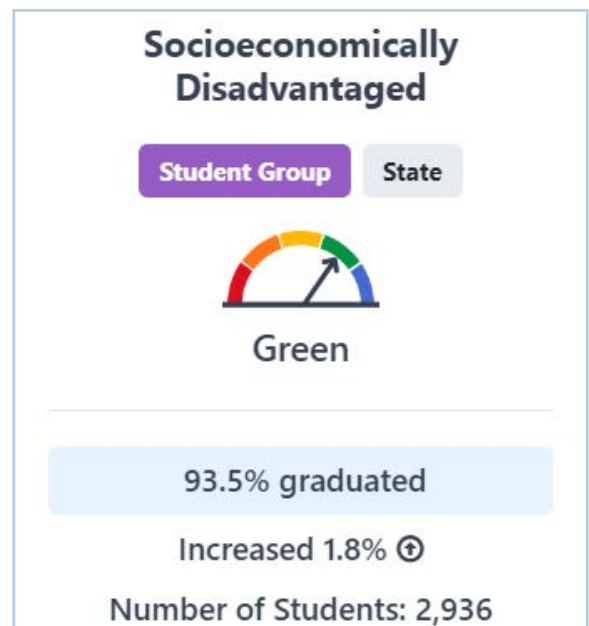
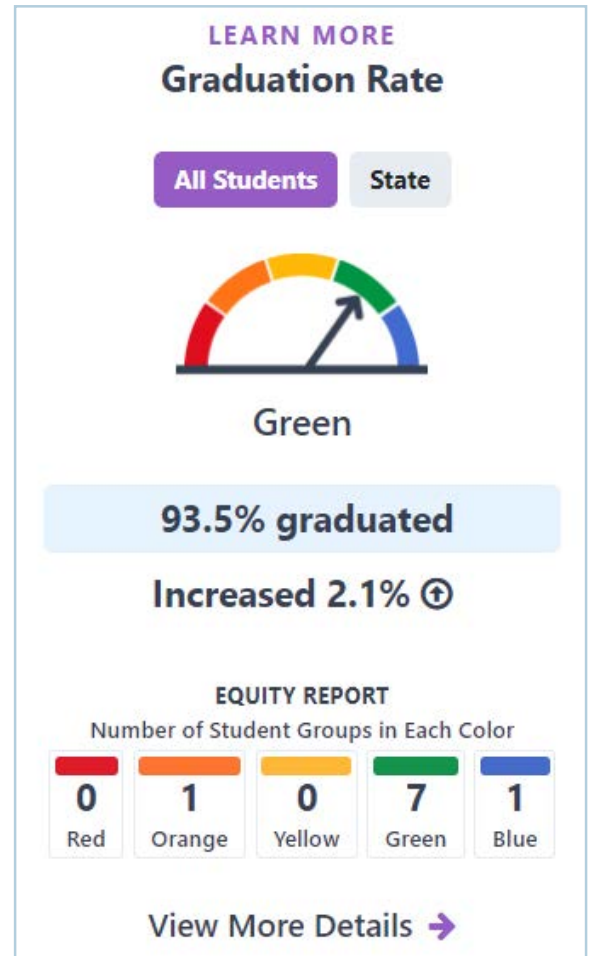
At the bottom of the card is an Equity Report. This report prominently displays the number of student groups placed in each performance level (color) for that measure. The Equity Report to the right shows that zero student groups received a Red (lowest performance), one student group received an Orange, zero student groups received a Yellow, seven student groups received a Green, and one student group received a Blue (highest performance).

6. Select the **View More Details** button below the Equity Report for detailed information on how student groups performed on that indicator. In the sample card provided to the right, the Socioeconomically Disadvantaged student group (with 2,936 students) received a Green performance level because in the current year, 93.5 percent of the students graduated, and there was an increase in the graduation rate of 1.8 percentage points from the prior year.
