FY2022.23 Revised Budget Narrative and Summary

Narrative and Summary for the Revised Budget report revenue and expenditures for the fiscal year 2022-23.

Revenue:

- A. State Aid School applied to PENSEC and the 20-day Special Apportionment in the second year of operations under a significantly expanding charter. The original budget was adjusted per reported enrollment and ADA numbers decreasing revenue. Annual projections account the Governor's budget compounded LCFF cost of living and additional discretionary adjustment resulting in a 13.26% LCFF cola increase.
- B. Federal Revenue Budget was adjusted per reported enrollment and ADA numbers. The School was awarded ESSER Funds, of which \$28,775 will be recognized in FY22-23.
- C. Other State Revenue Original budget was adjusted per reported enrollment and ADA numbers. The school was also awarded a Learning Recovery Block Grant of \$82,350 and an Instructional Material Block Grant of \$22,895, resulting in an increase in Other State revenue.
- D. Other Local Revenue The schools entered into a sub-lease agreement. The rate per square foot is comparable to that of the geographic area.

Expenses:

- A. Certificated Salaries A decrease in salary expenses due to changes in the staffing model led by enrollment changes.
- B. Classified Salaries Increase in salary expenses due to changes in the staffing model led by enrollment changes.
- C. Employee Benefits Decrease in employee benefits relative to staffing model changes.
- D. Books and Supplies Budget was adjusted per reported enrollment and ADA numbers. Non-Capitalized equipment expenses decreased due to donations.
- E. Sub-agreement Services and Other Operating Expenses Special Education agreement services were adjusted per reported enrollment and ADA numbers.
- F. Operations and Housekeeping Liability insurance was previously overestimated and has been adjusted to actual carrier premium commercial package.

- G. Facilities, Repairs, and Other Leases Increase the cost to repairs and maintenance of the facility.
- H. Professional/Consulting Services A decrease in budgeted revenue for the year impacts the forecasted District Oversight Fees and lowers the expense for the year.
- I. Depreciation Capitalized equipment purchased; financials are now depreciating expenses.
- J. Interest Expenses Reporting interest on repayment of the Charter School Revolving Loan Program and forecasted sales of receivables for the year.
