**SUBJECT:** Item 10 – Elementary and Secondary Education Act: Approve Proposed Changes to the Governing Policy of the Title I Committee of Practitioners and Appoint Members to the Title I Committee of Practitioners.

### Summary of Key Issues and Recommendation for Committee Appointments

On July 13, 2012, the State Board of Education (SBE) screening committee reviewed applications and interviewed 23 candidates for appointment as members of the Title I Committee of Practitioners. The following are the recommended appointments to the Title I Committee of Practitioners. Recommended appointment terms, in years, are cited in parentheses after each individual's name.

### Recommendation to Re-Open Procurement and Delegate Nomination Authority to the State Board of Education Screening Committee
