


**CERTIFICATION THAT WINTON HIGH WILL COMPLY WITH ALL  
APPLICABLE LAW**

Winton Charter High School (“Winton High”) hereby certifies that it shall comply with all applicable laws including, but not limited to, the following:

- Winton High shall meet all statewide standards and conduct the student assessments required, pursuant to Education Code Section 60605, and any other statewide standards authorized in statute, or student assessments applicable to students in non-charter public schools. (Ed. Code, § 47605(c)(1).)
- Winton High shall be deemed the exclusive public school employer of the employees of Winton High for purposes of the Educational Employment Relations Act. (Ed. Code, § 47605(b)(5)(O).)
- Winton High shall be non-sectarian in its programs, admissions policies, employment practices, and all other operations. (Ed. Code, § 47605(d)(1).)
- Winton High shall not charge tuition. (Ed. Code, § 47605(d)(1).)
- Winton High shall admit all students who wish to attend Winton High, and who submit a timely application. If Winton High receives a greater number of applications for the spaces available for students, each application will be given equal chance of admission through a public random drawing process. PreferenceEds shall be extended to pupils currently attending the charter school and pupils who reside in the district except as provided for in Ed. Code Section 47614.5. Other preferences may be permitted if consistent with the law. Except as described above, and as required by law, admission to Winton High shall not be determined according to the place of residence of the student or his or her parents within the State. In the event of a drawing, the chartering authority shall make reasonable efforts to accommodate the growth of Winton High. (Ed. Code, § 47605(d)(1)-(2).)
- Winton High shall not discriminate on the basis of the characteristics listed in Education Code Section 220 (actual or perceived disability, gender, gender identity, gender expression, nationality, race or ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or any other characteristic that is contained in the definition of hate crimes set forth in Section 422.55 of the Penal Code or association with an individual who has any of the aforementioned characteristics). (Ed. Code, § 47605(d)(1).)
- Winton High shall adhere to all provisions of federal law related to students with disabilities including, but not limited to, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and the Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act of 2004.
- Winton High shall meet all requirements for employment set forth in applicable provisions of law, including, but not limited to, credentials, as necessary. (5 C.C.R., § 11967.5.1(f)(5)(C).)

Winton Charter High School Signed Affirmations of Compliance

- Winton High shall ensure that teachers in Winton High hold a Commission on Teacher Credentialing certificate, permit, or other document equivalent to that which a teacher in other public schools is required to hold. As allowed by statute, flexibility will be given to non-core, non-college preparatory teachers. (Ed. Code, § 47605(l).)
- Winton High shall at all times maintain all necessary and appropriate insurance coverage.
- Winton High shall, for each fiscal year, offer, at a minimum, the required number of minutes of instruction based on grade level. (Ed. Code, § 47612.5(a)(1)(A)-(D).)
- If a pupil is expelled or leaves Winton High without graduating or completing the school year for any reason, Winton High shall notify the superintendent of the school district of the pupil's last known address within 30 days, and shall, upon request, provide that school district with a copy of the cumulative record of the pupil, including a transcript of grades or report card and health information. (Ed. Code, § 47605(d)(3).)
- Winton High shall maintain accurate and contemporaneous written records that document all pupil attendance and make these records available for audit and inspection as required by law. (Ed. Code, § 47612.5(a)(2).)
- Winton High shall on a regular basis consult with its parents, legal guardians, and teachers regarding Winton High's education programs. (Ed. Code, § 47605(c)(2).)
- Winton High shall comply with any jurisdictional limitations to locations of its facilities. (Ed. Code, §§ 47605 & 47605.1.)
- Winton High shall comply with all laws establishing the minimum and maximum age for public school enrollment. (Ed. Code, §§ 47610(c) & 47612(b).)
- Winton High shall comply with all applicable portions of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act and the Every Student Succeeds Act.
- Winton High shall comply with the Public Records Act.
- Winton High shall comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act.
- Winton High shall comply with the Ralph M. Brown Act.
- Winton High shall meet or exceed the legally required minimum number of school days. (5 C.C.R., § 11960(b).)
