On behalf of the California State University, I would like to thank you for the tremendous effort and accomplishment of making it through the first year of CAASPP testing. We understand the transition was challenging but through your commitment and dedication, the state of California tested over 2.7 million students. Now we move to the continuing challenge of communicating to students what their results mean. To this end, the CSU is here to support you.

We have developed several Early Assessment Program resources to assist in your efforts of communicating CAASPP EAP results to your students. Enclosed you will find “Your Pathway to College Readiness” posters and “Your Guide to College Readiness”. The poster is designed for both juniors and seniors, and the guide is designed for seniors. Both pieces describe how the CSU is using CAASPP results as an early signal of their readiness to take college level credit bearing courses upon enrolling at a CSU, and what they should do next.
