

# Smarter Balanced Training Tests, Practice Tests, and Interim Assessments At-a-Glance

There are many tools available to teachers to gauge their students' learning, prepare them for the summative and alternate assessments for English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics, and engage families in student learning. This document provides a side-by-side comparison of training tests, practice tests, and interim assessments to help teachers decide which tool best fits their needs.

Information	Training Tests	Practice Tests	Interim Assessments
<b>Purpose</b>	Allow students to become familiar with the testing interface and available accessibility resources.	Provide students with opportunities to become familiar with the format and structure of a summative assessment.	Provide teachers with information on student performance to help gauge students' knowledge and skills.
<b>Grade Levels</b>	One test is available for each grade span—grades three through five, grades six through eight, and high school.	One test is available for each tested grade level: grades three through eight and high school.	One mathematics and one ELA Interim Comprehensive Assessment (ICA) and multiple Interim Assessment Blocks (IABs) are available for each tested grade level: grades three through eight and high school.
<b>Items</b>	Approximately 6 items are available for each ELA and mathematics per grade span.	Approximately 30 ELA items, 30 mathematics items, 1 ELA performance task, and 1 mathematics performance task are available per grade level.	IABs include 5 to 15 items, and ICAs contain 35 to 50 items. Some IABs and all ICAs require hand scoring.
<b>Scoring</b>	No scoring guides are available.	Scoring guides are available to assist in scoring.	Answer keys and hand scoring guides are available. Results are reported once all scoring (including hand scoring) has been completed and submitted.
<b>Logon</b>	Access is available to anyone through a guest logon at <a href="https://www.caaspp.org/practice-and-training/">https://www.caaspp.org/practice-and-training/</a> . <b>Opportunities</b>	There is an unlimited number of testing opportunities.	There is an unlimited number of testing opportunities.	There is an unlimited number of testing opportunities for IABs and up to three opportunities for each student per ICA.
