Approve Audeo II Petition

- Strong petition meeting all requirements of 16 elements
- Appreciate the CDE and SBE staff recommendation for approval
- **Appreciate the ACCS recommendation to the SBE for approval of petition and all resource centers listed**
- Include all resource centers listed in the petition for approval

Audeo Charter School Renewal by SDUSD

- 2015 unanimously renewed for a fourth charter term
- SDUSD classifies Audeo as a K-12 Independent Study Program
- Clarifications to renewal: 5 resource centers outside SDUSD attendance boundaries removed from petition
- 2010 renewal included Carlsbad and Escondido resource centers
- Alternative authorization for these existing 5 resource centers to create **AUDEO II**
- Likely hundreds of such resource centers across the state - the practice is widely accepted, and SBE is previously on record in support of resource centers outside of district boundaries (**e.g. Olive Grove Charter School in 2015**)

Petition presented to CUSD

- Growing demand for Audeo program in Carlsbad
- 398 CUSD students served by Audeo in 2015-16 school year
- Letter from SDUSD to Carlsbad Unified expressing Audeo's "Good Standing" and urging **AUDEO II** petition approval by the Carlsbad Unified School District
- CUSD has never approved a charter school
- SDCOE has not approved a charter school since 2001




School Design

Audeo Accomplishments


- Top 2% of ASAM schools API Scores
