

Community Need

The establishment of ISLA is in response to 4 specific community needs:

- The popularity of dual language immersion programs. At Franklin over 500 applications were received for around 100 spots
- The desire for additional high-quality public schools of choice
- The projected need for additional schools in the high multi-unit housing development areas of southern and western Glendale
- A second elementary feeder is needed that creates a viable middle school option for French, Italian and German, establishing equanimity across all FLAG programs

We collected 131 stakeholder support letters for SBE authorization.


