



Dear Mr. Medeiros,

Under the provisions of Education Code this office must review and based on its review, either approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove the budgets of school districts within Kings County. The following code sections are important to this process:

E.C. 42127(a) requires school districts to adopt a budget on or before July 1 of each year and submit it to the county superintendent within five days of adoption or by July 1, whichever occurs first.

E.C. 42127(c)(1) requires the county superintendent to examine the adopted budget for compliance of State adopted Standards and Criteria for the purpose of identifying technical corrections necessary to bring the budget into compliance if it is not.

E.C. 42127 (c)(2) requires the county superintendent to determine whether the adopted budget will allow the district to meet its financial obligations during the fiscal year and two subsequent years.

Our analysis must now include, under AB 2756, any reports or studies that show signs of fiscal distress.

From our analysis, based on the district budget reports and projections provided, we conclude that:

- The district has met the criteria and standards
- The district will meet its financial obligations in the current year and two subsequent years based on the district's multi-year projection.

Based on our analysis and review, we approve the adopted budget of the district.
