The course fee may be paid by check, money order, or purchase order, and is due no later than the first day of the applicant's assigned class. Cash payments are not accepted. Cancellations 90 days or more prior to the course are eligible for a 100% refund of the course fee, cancellations less than 90 days but more than 30 days prior to the course are eligible for a 50% refund, and cancellations 30 days or less prior to the course are ineligible for a refund. If the applicant is an approved delegated behind-the-wheel trainer, then a document verifying completion of high school level education is not required.
