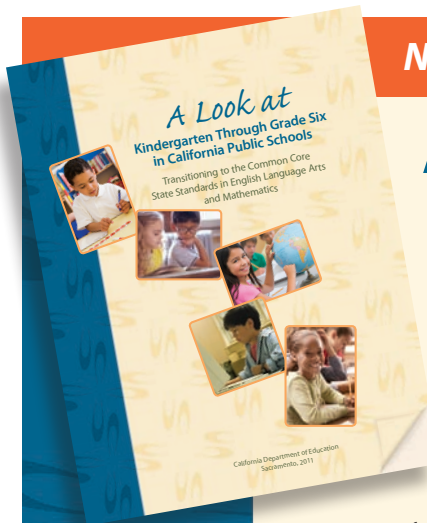

Transitioning to the Common Core State Standards in English Language Arts and Mathematics

The integration of the new Common Core State Standards (CCSS) into instructional practice, standards-based materials, and assessments has begun. To provide assistance during this transition to the CCSS, the California Department of Education (CDE) has developed a useful resource: *A Look at Kindergarten Through Grade Six in California Public Schools: Transitioning to the Common Core State Standards in English Language Arts and Mathematics*.

The CDE Press is pleased to announce the release of this new publication. It can be used by teachers and grade-level teams, by administrators for professional development and schoolwide curriculum planning, and by parents to learn more about the new standards and how they are likely to impact their children's education.

The publication is excerpted from *A Look at Kindergarten Through Grade Six in California Public Schools*, an online resource that provides information regarding all curricular content areas in the course of study: history–social science, science, physical education, health, visual and performing arts, world languages, and school library, in addition to the English language arts and mathematics sections. *A Look at Kindergarten Through Grade Six in California Public Schools*, in its entirety, is included in CD-ROM format with the new print publication.

The publication features:

- Grade-level chapters that include short descriptive narratives and the content standards for English language arts and mathematics
- An overview highlighting each content area and a short summary of what proficient students learned in the previous grade
- A "Support for English Learners" section in each content area that identifies a few of the difficulties English learners may face and some recommendations to help them gain access to the curriculum
- An Introduction with general information about key *Education Code* sections related to standards and courses, in addition to other educational issues that affect instruction
- A list of Web-based resources from the CDE, the federal government, and other agencies and organizations.
