# Proposed Regulations Available for 60-Day Public Comment

- Proposed regulations for Accountability, State Plans, and Data Reporting were released on May 31, 2016.
- Public comment period closes on August 1, 2016.
- Areas of concern include:
  - Summative Rating Requirements and Methodology
  - State Plan Timelines
  - Approach to Weighting of Indicators
  - School Improvement Plans
  - State, LEA, and School Report Cards
  - Alternative Schools

## **Draft Plan Development Timeline\***

Time Period	Plan Development Activities
April–May	Engage stakeholders in surfacing questions, decisions, and opportunities
June–July	Develop plan outline based on proposed regulations from U.S.  Department of Education (ED)  Begin drafting Plan  Continue stakeholder engagement activities
August–September	Draft plan completed 30-day public comment period Continue stakeholder engagement activities
October–November	Incorporate public comment and State Board of Education (SBE) feedback into Plan
December–January	Plan approved by SBE, sent to ED
