



**Percent of English Learner Students Who Made Progress Toward English Proficiency**




**Percent of English Learner Students Who Were Reclassified**

**2014-15 Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity**








**Percent of English Learner Students Who Made Progress Toward English Proficiency**



**Percent of English Learner Students Who Were Reclassified**





**Percent of English Learner Students Who Made Progress Toward English Proficiency**




**Percent of English Learner Students Who Were Reclassified**

**2014-15 Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity**



**Percent of English Learner Students Who Made Progress Toward English Proficiency**




**Percent of English Learner Students Who Were Reclassified**

**2014-15 Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity**


