

Reviewer Deliberations and Report(s) of Findings: DoubleTree by Hilton Hotel in Sacramento

- **Plan to be available the weeks of July 20–24 or July 27–31, 2026, for Deliberations (Reviewers must attend all four days of their assigned week.)**

The CDE will reimburse travel costs for all reviewers for the meeting days. Reviewers will receive a \$100 stipend per day for full participation in the four days of reviewer training in April–May 2026 and the four days of deliberations in July 2026.
