


# DASS One-Year Graduation Rate



The Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS) one-year graduation rate is reported for informational purposes and local planning and analyses. It is not used for accountability or state and federal support determinations.

## Calculating the DASS One-Year Graduation Rate

The DASS one-year graduation rate is the percentage of students who are enrolled in grade twelve (along with early grade eleven graduates) and meet specific enrollment requirements. Unlike the combined four- and five-year graduation rate—which only counts students who earned a standard high school diploma or an alternative pathway diploma as graduates—students who completed specific certificates, earned the California Proficiency Program, or earned an adult education diploma are counted as graduates in the one-year DASS graduation rate, as referenced in this figure:
