

College/Career Indicator: Measures of Readiness



The College/Career Indicator (CCI) shows how well local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools are preparing graduates for college and/or career. Graduates who meet specific CCI “Prepared” criteria are included in the calculations of the CCI. The following measures have been approved by the State Board of Education as indicating college/career readiness. Component Definitions

Many CCI measures have been approved as a combination of components to indicate an LEA or school has prepared students for college/career. The component criteria are detailed below, with all possible combinations that make up the measures in the table that follows.

AP: Complete one Advanced Placement (AP) course with a grade of C– or better or exam with a score of 3 or higher

CI: Complete one Cambridge International A or AS level course with a grade of C– or better or exam with a score of E/e or better

IB: Complete one International Baccalaureate (IB) course with a grade of C– or better or exam with a score of 4 or higher

CC: Complete one semester/two trimesters/two quarters of college credit course high school with a grade of C– or better in approved subjects where college credits are awarded

CTE P: Complete Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathway with a grade of C– or better in the capstone course

UC/CSU: Meet the University of California/California State University (UC/CSU) admission requirements

SB I: Receive a score of Level 3 or higher in one subject area (English language arts/literacy [ELA] or mathematics) on the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments and a score of Level 2 or higher in the other

SB II: Receive a score of Level 3 or higher in ELA on the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments

SSB: Earn the State Seal of Biliteracy (SSB)

SSCE: Complete the State Seal of Civic Engagement (SSCE)

WBL: Complete high-quality Work-Based Learning: Internship, Student-Led Enterprise, or Simulated Work-Based Learning

LMS: Complete two years of leadership/military science

ASVAB: Score 31 or higher on the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) Armed Forces Qualification Test

SFJP: Complete a State and Federal Job Program*

CTE C: Complete one CTE course with a grade of C– or better*

TWBE: Complete a Transition Work-Based Experience**

TCBWE: Complete a Transition Classroom-Based Work Exploration**

*Components that make up the State and Federal Job Programs measure available to Dashboard Alternative School Status (DASS) schools only.

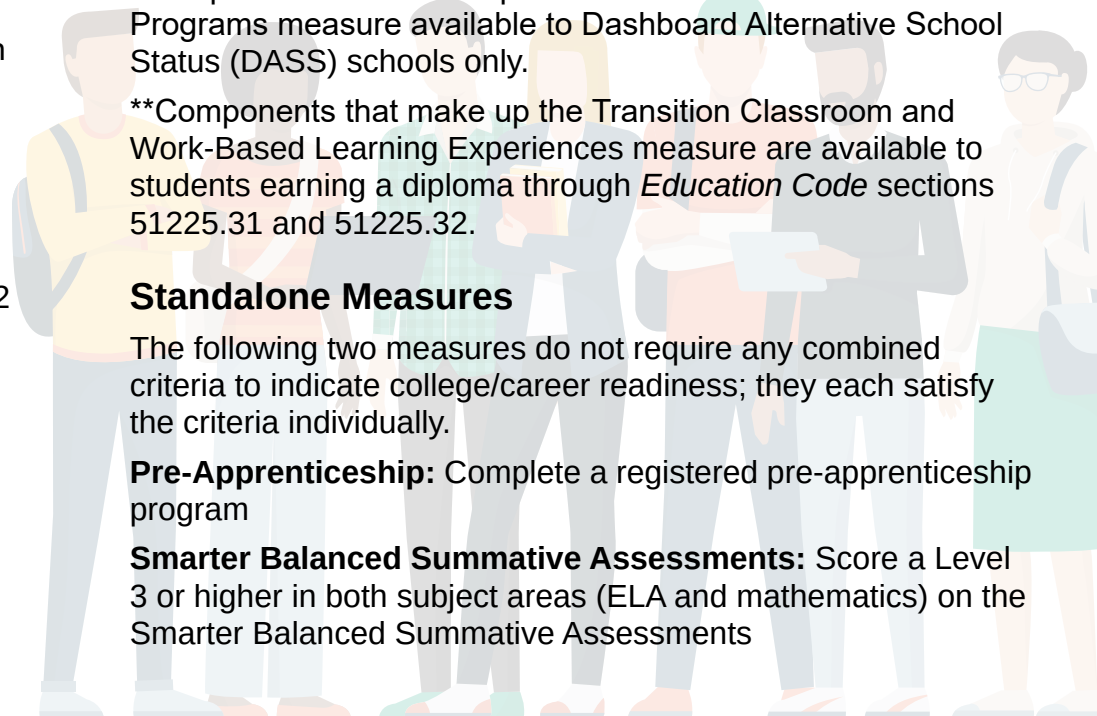
**Components that make up the Transition Classroom and Work-Based Learning Experiences measure are available to students earning a diploma through *Education Code* sections 51225.31 and 51225.32.

Standalone Measures

The following two measures do not require any combined criteria to indicate college/career readiness; they each satisfy the criteria individually.

Pre-Apprenticeship: Complete a registered pre-apprenticeship program

Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments: Score a Level 3 or higher in both subject areas (ELA and mathematics) on the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments

The following combinations of measures have been approved by the State Board of Education as indicating college/career readiness, indicated by **Y** in the table below.
