

Differences Between the 2022 and 2023 Dashboards



Compared to the 2022 California School Dashboard (Dashboard), the 2023 Dashboard reflects a full return of California’s accountability system. Because changes were made between the 2022 and 2023 Dashboards, the table below identifies the general differences as they relate to **state and local indicators**.

| Item | 2022 Dashboard | 2023 Dashboard |
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| Basics: Teachers, Instructional Materials, Facilities | Local educational agencies (LEAs) self-reported the Teacher Mis-Assignments and Vacant Teacher Positions to the Dashboard and a link was provided to access the LEAs Teacher Assignment and Monitoring Outcomes (AMO) data report. | Appropriately Assigned Teachers data are prepopulated by the California Department of Education (CDE). LEAs are no longer self-reporting Teacher Mis-Assignments and Vacant Teacher Positions. |
| Change (Difference Between Current and Prior Year Data) | Change was not calculated due to requirements under Assembly Bill 130 that only the most current year of data (or Status) was to be displayed for all state indicators except for the College/Career Indicator (CCI). | Change is calculated for all state indicators except for the CCI. |
| Performance Levels (Colors) and Five-by-Five Colored Tables | Because only Status was displayed, Performance Levels using the five-by-five colored tables were not determined. | Performance Levels using the five-by-five colored tables are determined for all state indicators except for the CCI. |
| CCI | With statewide assessment results unavailable in 2020–21 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the CCI was not reported on the Dashboard. | CCI is reported but with only current year data (Status). |
| English Learner Progress Indicator (ELPI) | Only Status was reported. | At the September 2023 State Board of Education (SBE) meeting, the SBE approved <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • change cut points; • a five-by-five colored table to determine Performance Levels (or color); and • a methodology to include the Summative Alternate English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (Alternate ELPAC) into the ELPI. With these three approvals, the ELPI will display performance colors for the first time using Summative ELPAC and Summative Alternate ELPAC results. |

| Three-by-Five Colored Table (Applied When the Denominator Is Less Than 150 Students) | With Change not calculated, the three-by-five methodology was not applied as it is founded on the removal of the “Increased Significantly” and “Declined Significantly” Change levels. | With Change calculated, the three-by-five methodology is once again applied to the Chronic Absenteeism, Graduation Rate, and Suspension Rate Indicators. |
| Differentiated Assistance under Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) | Only the Status levels for the state indicators were used for differentiated assistance determinations. Additionally, only districts and county offices of education (COEs) were eligible for differentiated assistance, as charter schools needed two years of data to make a determination. | Performance colors for the state indicators will be used to determine districts, COEs, and charter schools eligible for differentiated assistance. Additionally, results from the local indicators will be used in eligibility determinations. |
| Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) and Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) Under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) | Only the Status levels for the state indicators were used for CSI—Low Performing and ATSI determinations. Additionally, only one year of Dashboard results were used in ATSI determinations. | Performance colors for the state indicators will be used to determine schools eligible for CSI—Low Performing and ATSI. Additionally, two years of Dashboard results (i.e., 2022 and 2023) will be used in ATSI eligibility determinations. |
