- G/GS_09 = grade span nine through twelve

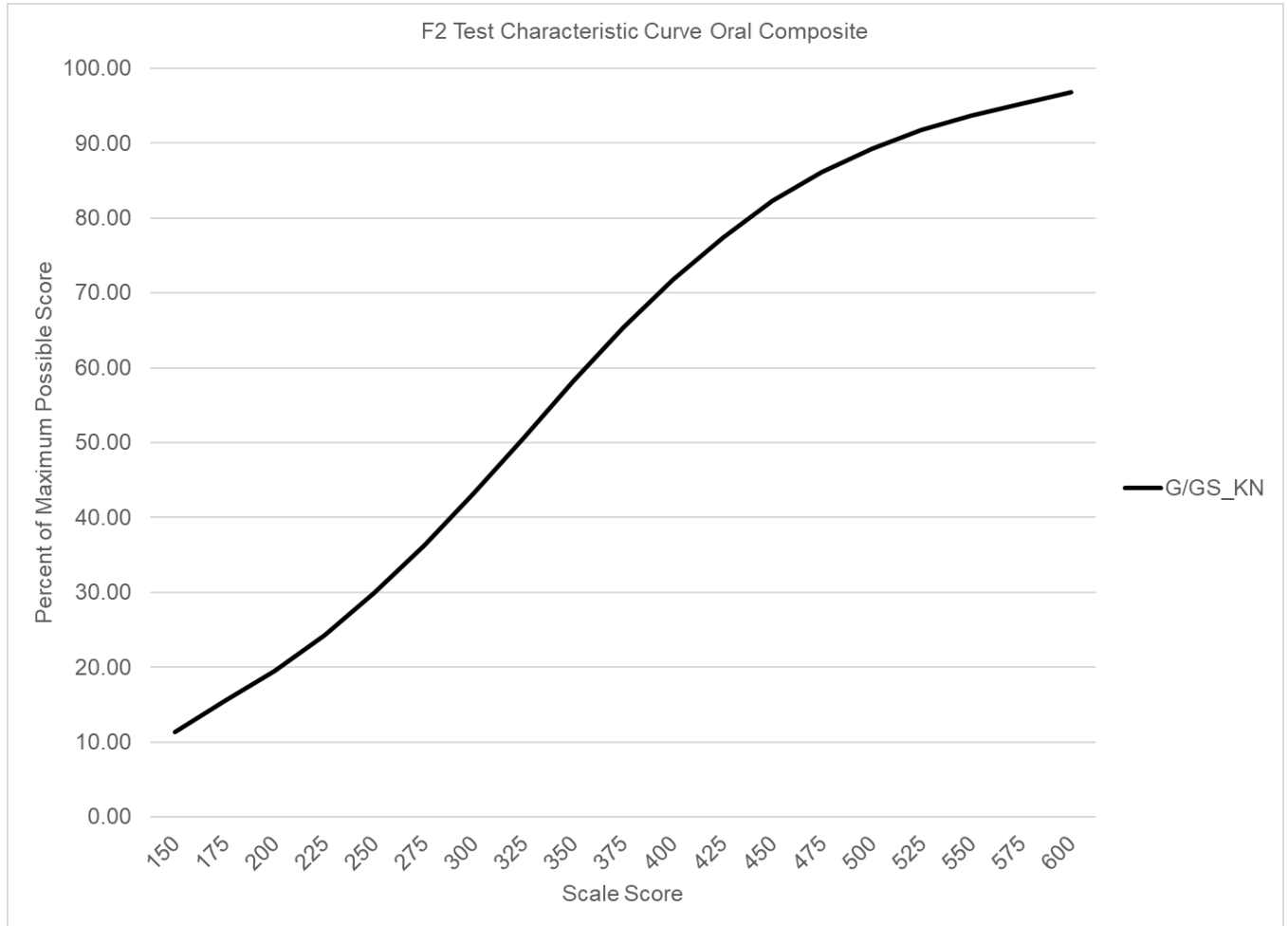


Figure 6.D.1 Oral test characteristic curve—kindergarten

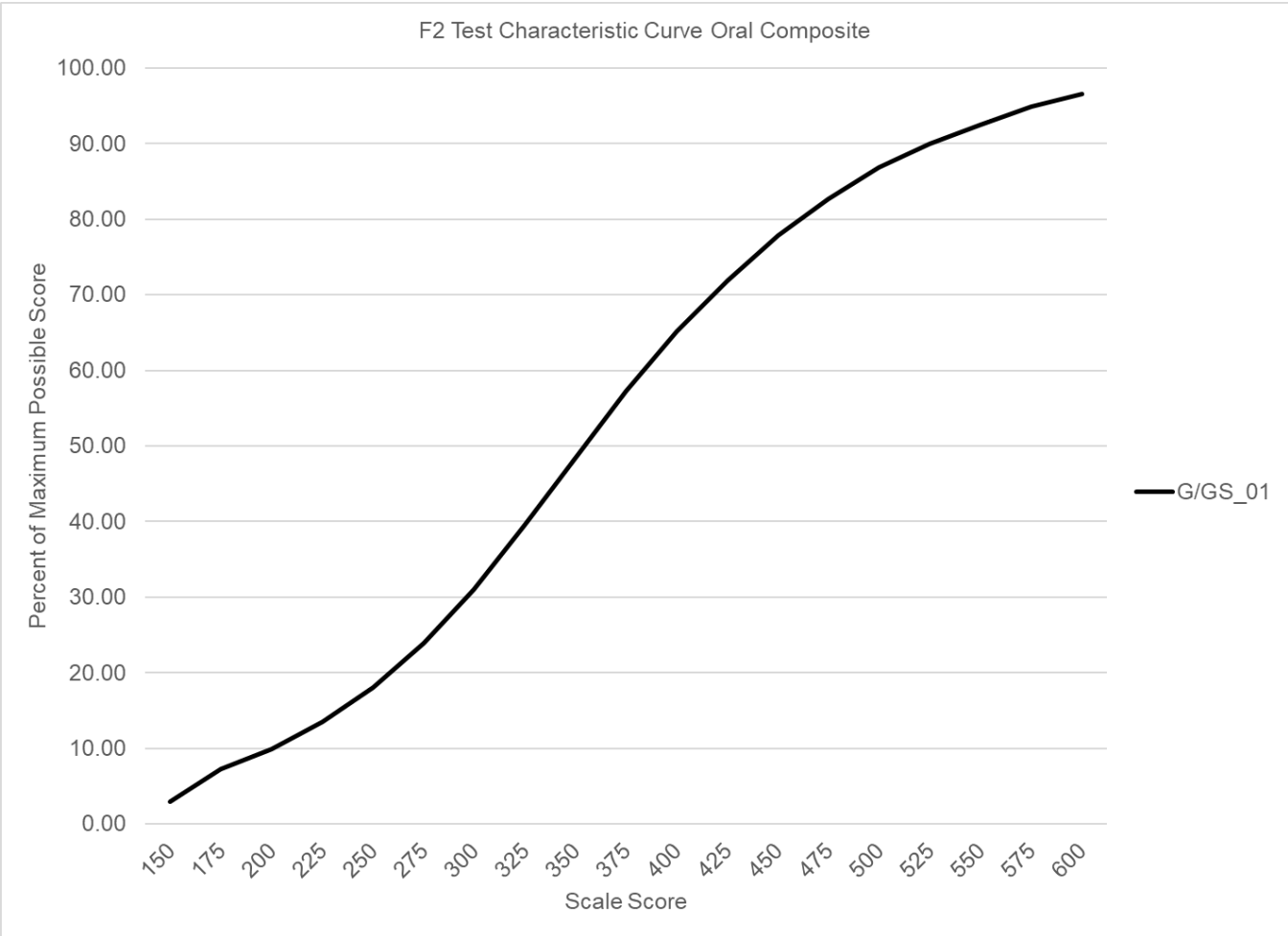


Figure 6.D.2 Oral test characteristic curve—grade one

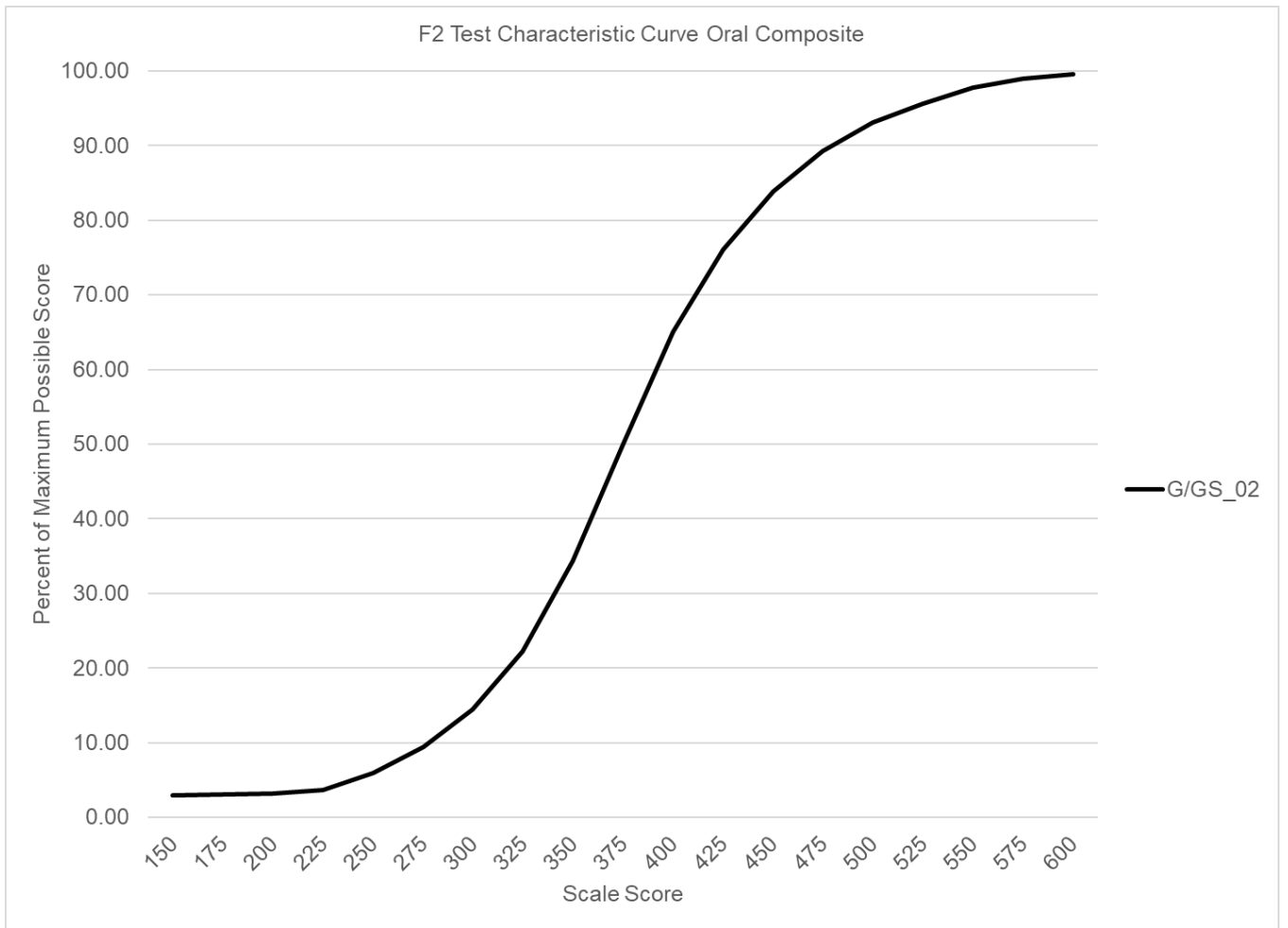


Figure 6.D.3 Oral test characteristic curve—grade two

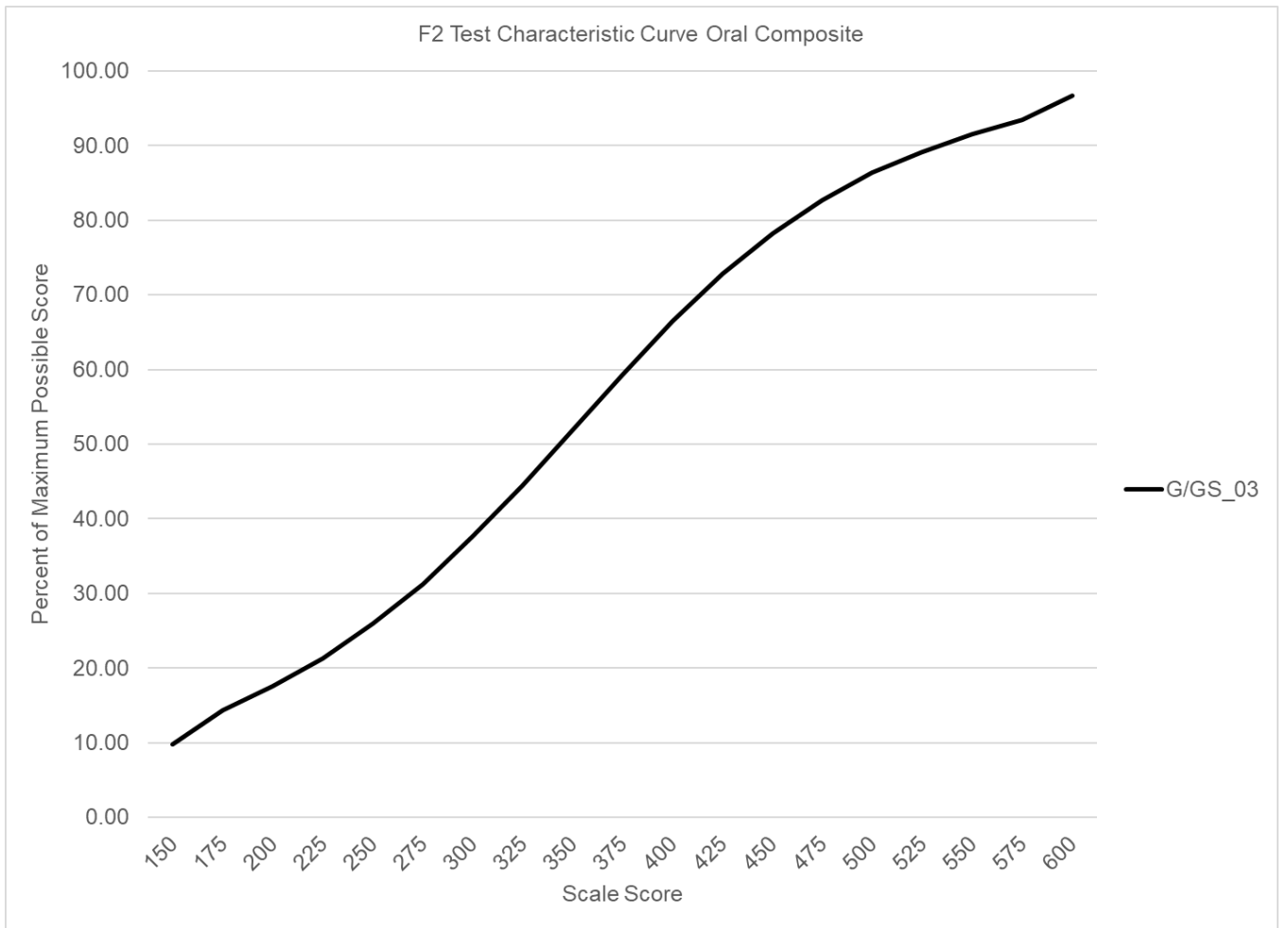


Figure 6.D.4 Oral test characteristic curve—grade span three through five

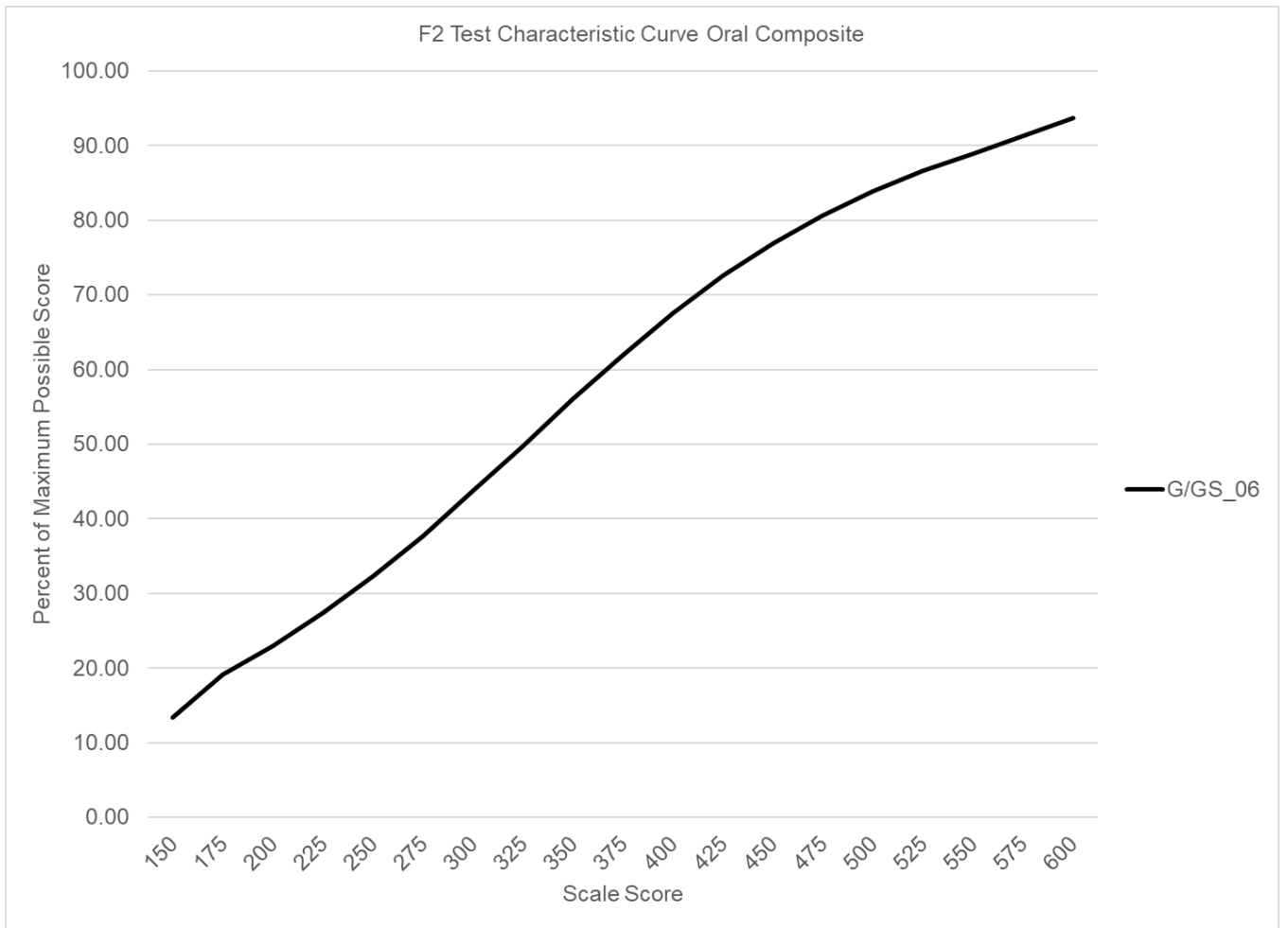


Figure 6.D.5 Oral test characteristic curve—grade span six through eight

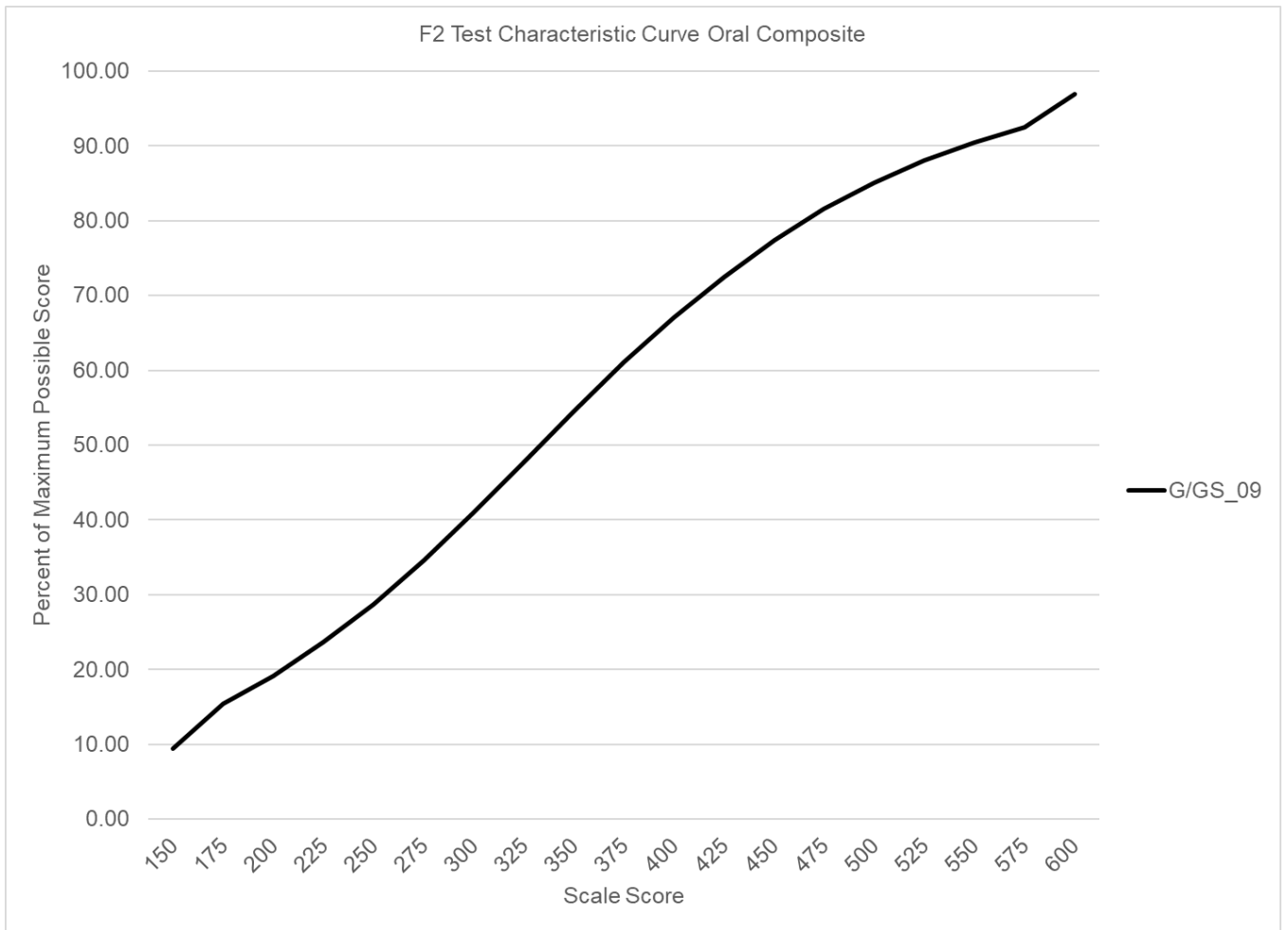


Figure 6.D.6 Oral test characteristic curve—grade span nine through twelve

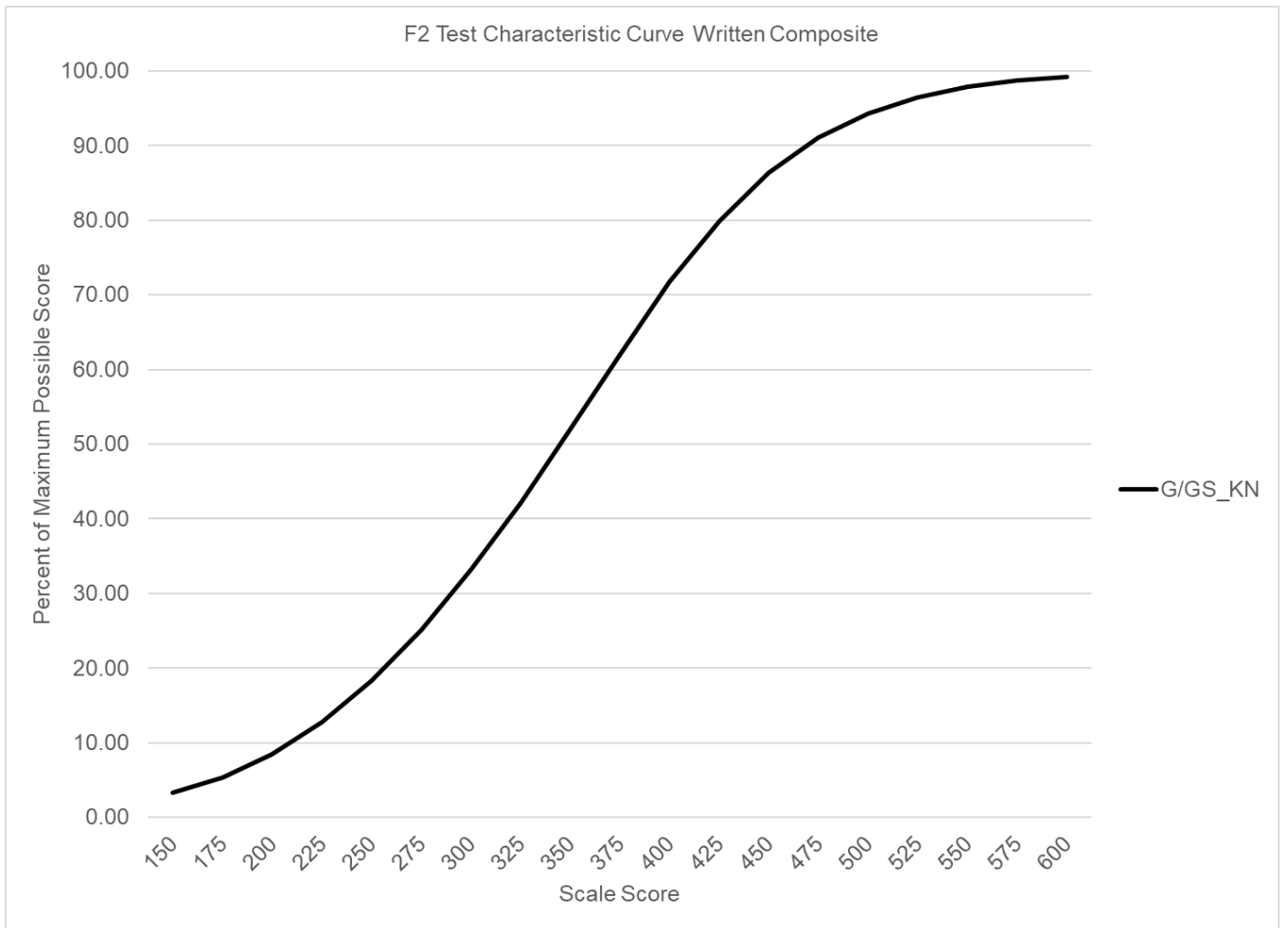


Figure 6.D.7 Written test characteristic curve—kindergarten

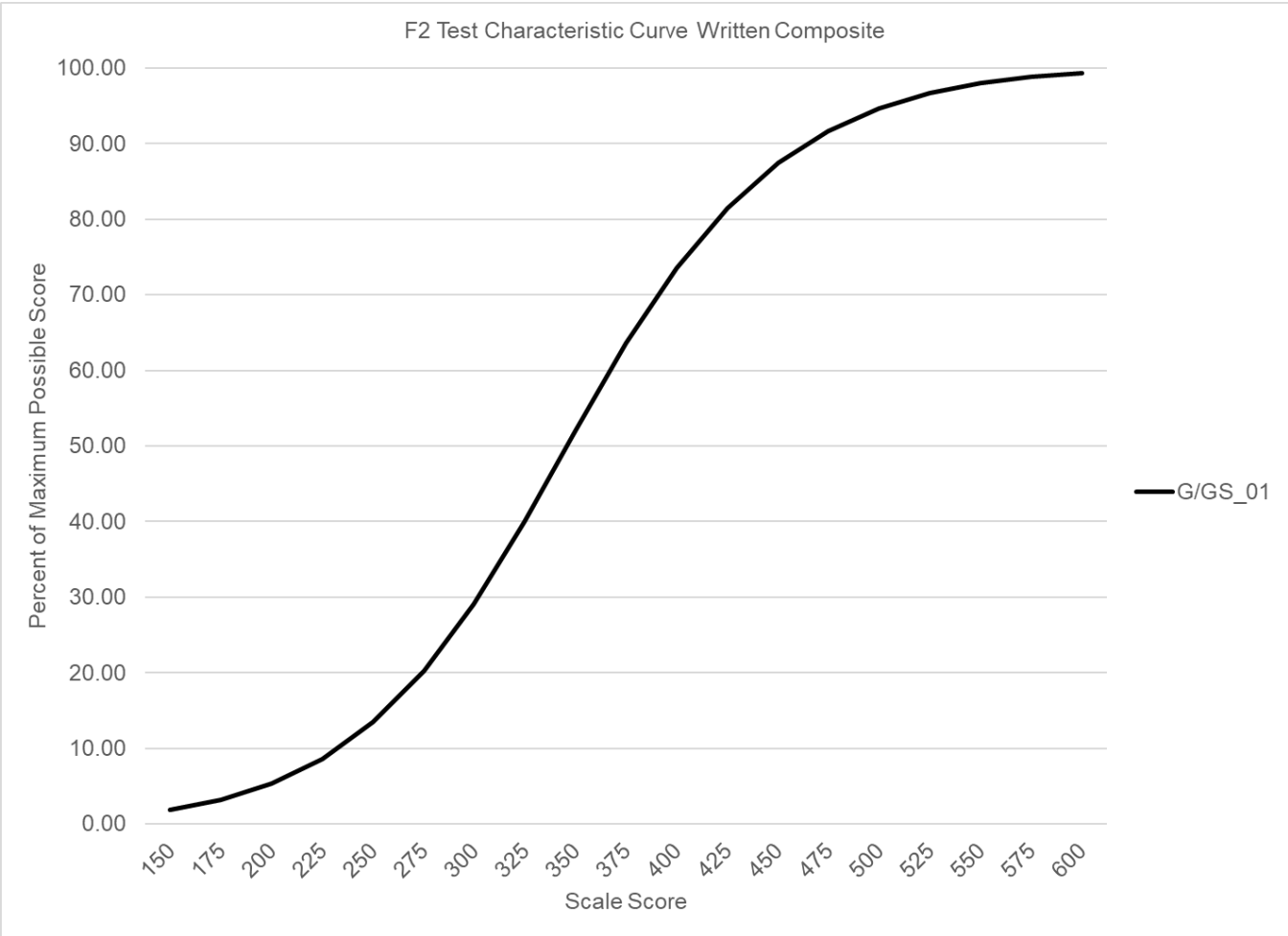


Figure 6.D.8 Written test characteristic curve—grade one

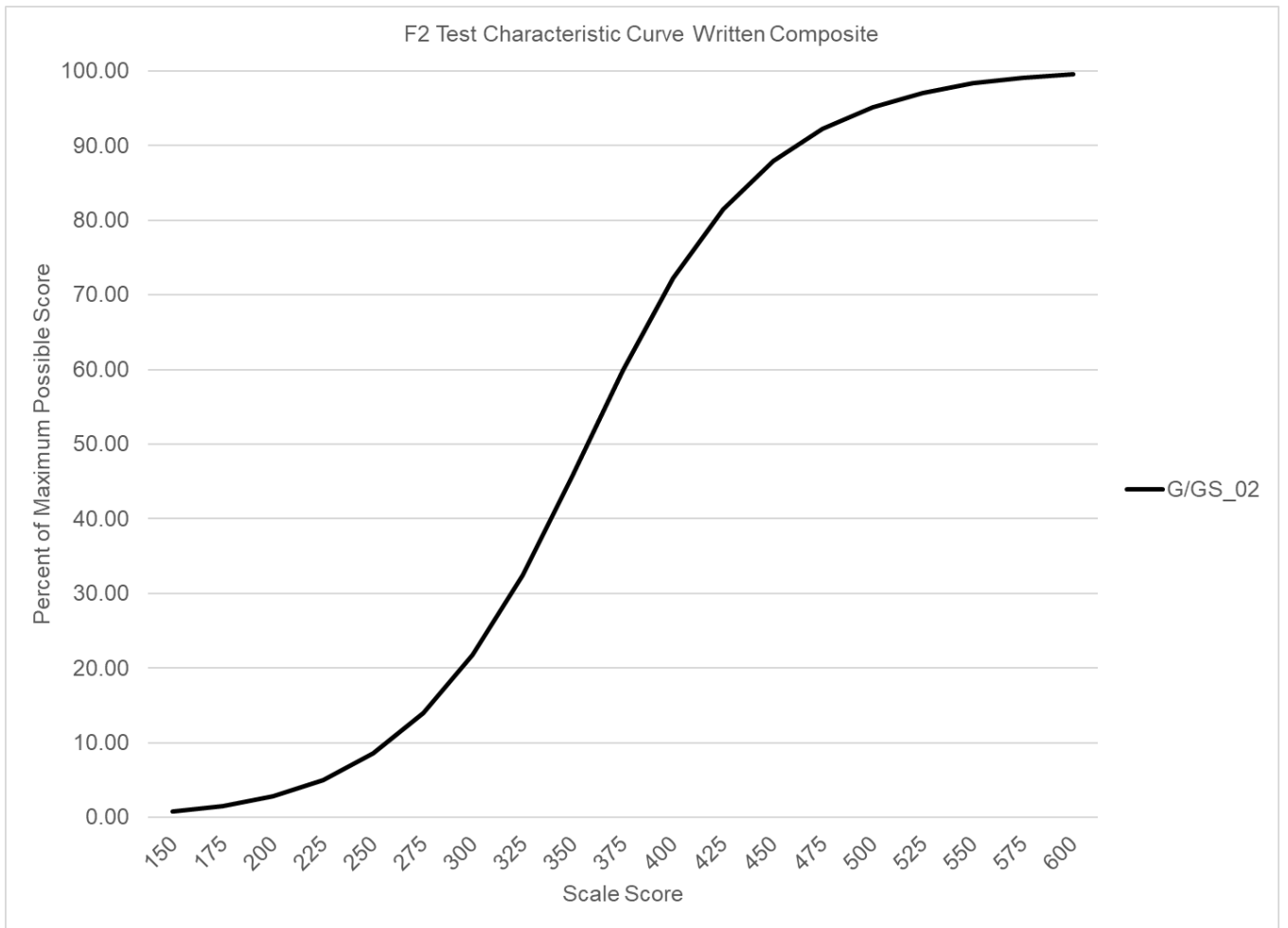


Figure 6.D.9 Written test characteristic curve—grade two

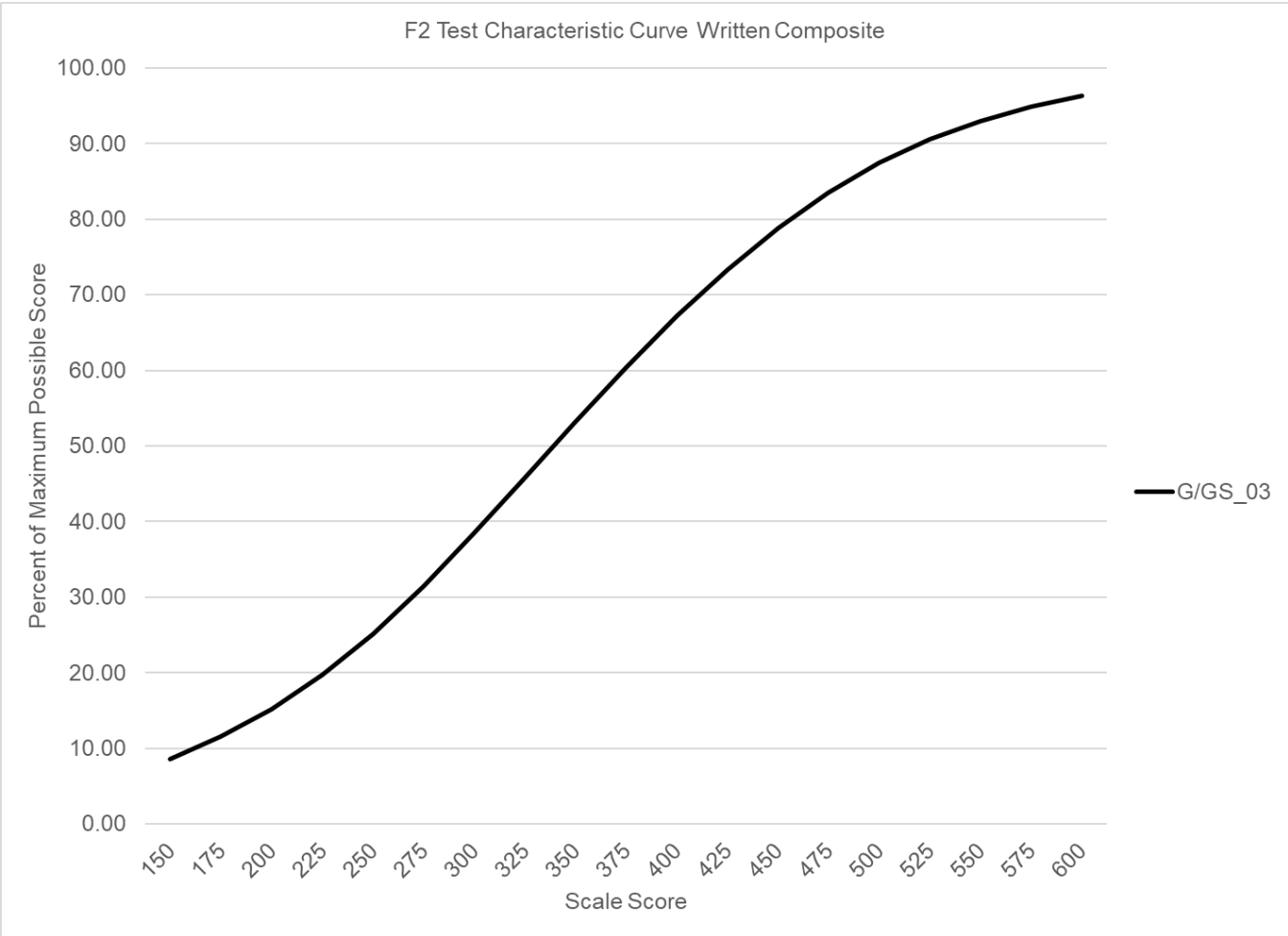


Figure 6.D.10 Written test characteristic curve—grade span three through five

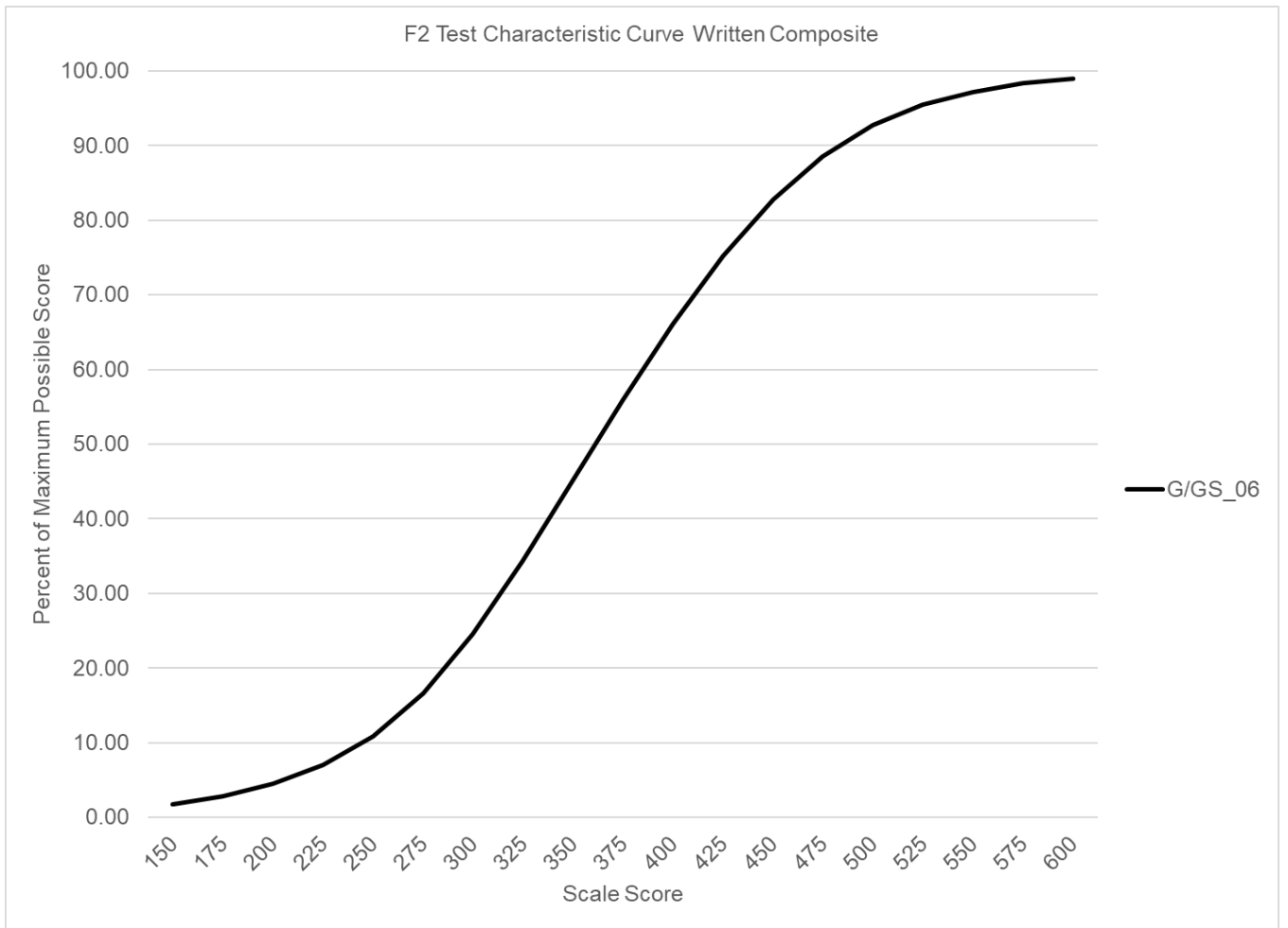


Figure 6.D.11 Written test characteristic curve—grade span six through eight

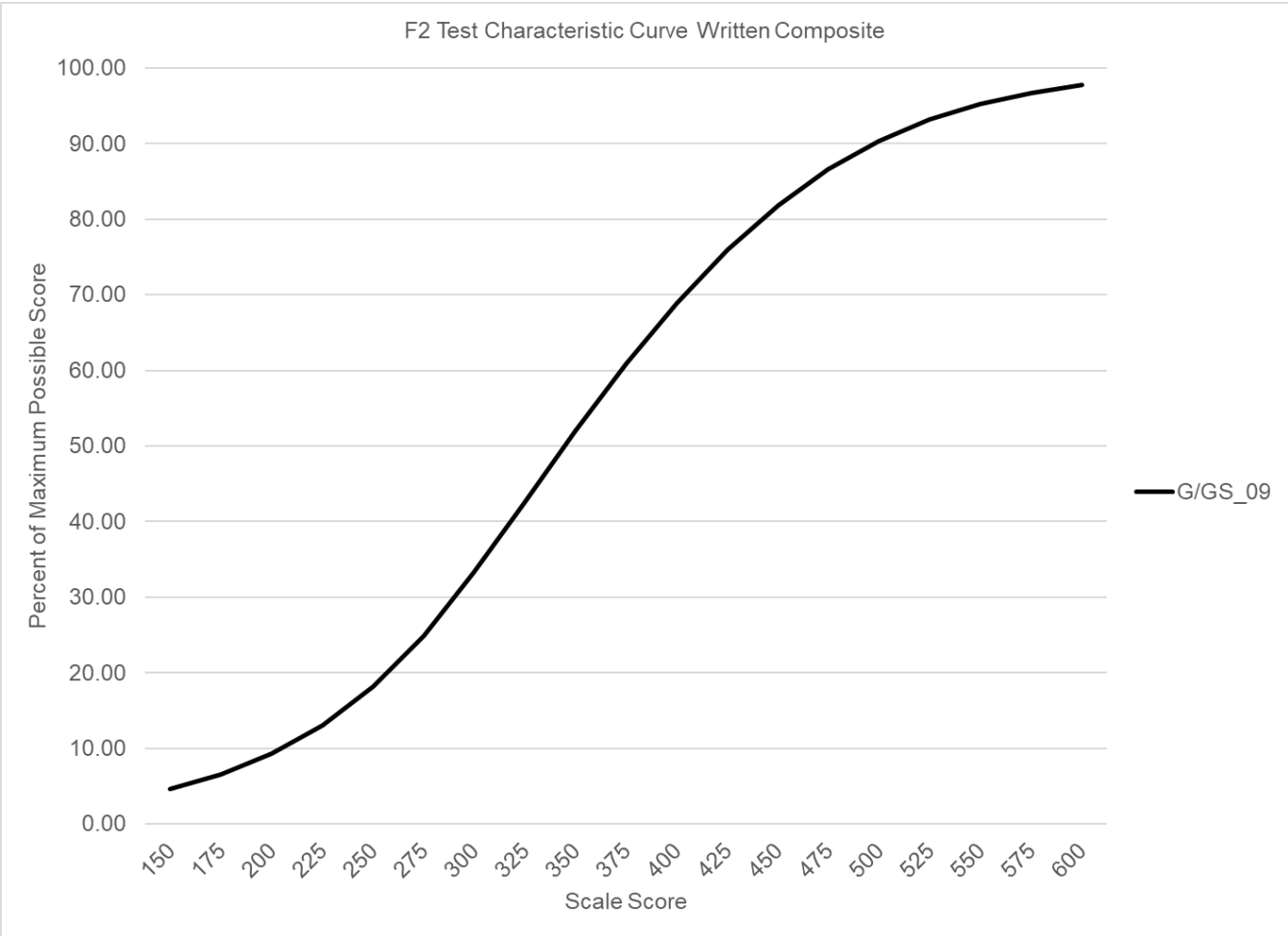


Figure 6.D.12 Written test characteristic curve—grade span nine through twelve
