English Learner Students' Academic Achievement




California reports the performance colors of the English learner (EL) student group on each state measure (i.e., Chronic Absenteeism, Graduation Rate, Suspension Rate, English Learner Progress, College/Career, and Academic). Additional expanded performance reports are targeted specifically for the EL student group on the Academic measures and California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) in English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics.

EL Students on the Academic Indicators

The California School Dashboard (Dashboard) reflects student performance for all students. Each card on the Dashboard includes an Equity Report which prominently displays the number of student groups placed in each Performance Level for that state measure.

Below the Equity Report is a **View More Details** link, which leads users to disaggregated student group data as reflected in the card. The Academic measures further disaggregate EL student group data by sharing the two components of the Academic measure EL student group: current EL students and recently reclassified EL students. Additionally, the performance for English Only students is shared for comparison. This report includes the number of students in each category and the Distance from Standard. The graphic below provides an example of this additional report for districts and schools.

Selecting the English-Language Fluency student group will provide reports for the following student subgroups:

- Initial Fluent English Proficient (IFEP)
- Reclassified as Fluent English Proficient (RFEP)
- EL students enrolled for less than 12 months
- EL students enrolled for 12 months or more
- EL students
- Adult EL students (ADEL)
- English Only (EO)
- Ever-EL
- TBD (to be determined)

Each report for these student subgroups provides the number and percentage of students at each of the CAASPP performance levels (i.e., Level 1—Not Met, Level 2—Nearly Met, Level 3—Met, Level 4—Exceeded) by grade level. A bar graph detailing the percentage of students at each performance level by grade level is provided for each student group.

Additionally, the California Department of Education (CDE) provides reports that detail results for each student subgroup's performance in each area of the CAASPP.
