

Long-Term English Learner Students on the California School Dashboard

Long-Term English Learner (LTEL) students were added as a student group across all state measures with the 2024 California School Dashboard (Dashboard). English learner (EL) students who have not been reclassified as fluent-English proficient within seven years are included in both the EL and LTEL student groups. The graphic below displays which students are included in the LTEL student group for each state measure.

Students Who Are Incorporated in the LTEL Student Group by State Measure



Academic—English Language Arts, Academic—Mathematics: Students who have been an EL for seven years or more during the current academic year.



College/Career: Students who have been an EL for seven years or more at any point during the last four or five years in high school.



English Learner Progress: Students who have been an EL for seven years or more during the current academic year.



Chronic Absenteeism: Students who have been an EL for seven years or more during the current academic year.



Graduation Rate: Students who have been an EL for seven years or more at any point during the last four or five years in high school.



Science: Students who have been an EL for seven years or more during the current academic year.



Suspension Rate: Students who have been an EL for seven years or more during the current academic year.
