## What Data Is Displayed on the 2025 Dashboard?



The 2025 California School Dashboard (Dashboard), California's accountability system, reports Status (current year data), Change (the difference from prior year data), and Performance Levels (or colors) for all state indicators. The table below identifies each state indicator and the data that are used to calculate Status and Change. Detailed information about each indicator, including calculations for Status and Change, can be found on the <u>California Department of Education (CDE) Dashboard Technical Guide web page</u>.

Note that all state indicator data published by the CDE reflects the most current data available which has been submitted and certified by local education agencies (LEAs).
