# Proposition 58

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## California Education for a Global Economy Initiative (CA Ed.G.E.)

- Passed November 8, 2016 by the voters
- Changes to California *Education Code (EC)*
  - Amended *EC* sections 300, 305, 306, 310, 320, and 335
  - Repealed *EC* Section 311
- Effective July 1, 2017



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# Language Programs

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Parents of English learners may choose a program for their child.

At a minimum, Structured English Immersion must be provided as a program choice.


The CA Ed.G.E. Initiative names two categories of programs:

- Language acquisition programs
  - Structured English Immersion
  - Dual Language Immersion
  - Transitional or Developmental

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# Regulations

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The proposed regulations:

- Provide clarity and direction to local educational agencies (LEAs) for implementation of the statute
- Provide a process that incorporates parents and school communities
- Afford LEAs time and structure to select and implement a language acquisition program



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# Rulemaking

## The Rulemaking Process:

- 45-day public comment period begins July 29, 2017
- Submit comments to [regcomments@cde.ca.gov](mailto:regcomments@cde.ca.gov)
- Public hearing September 11, 2017
- State Board of Education November meeting
  - Possible adoption of regulations or additional 15-day public comment period
- Submit regulations to the Office of Administrative Law for final approval
