



# Legislation language

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Provide professional development and regional training for teachers, administrators, and paraprofessionals on the curriculum frameworks, including but not limited to Armenian Genocide, labor, LGBT and civic education components for the History Social Science Framework and sexual harassment and violence prevention for the Health Framework.

Provide access to an online repository of resources to support the History Social Science framework and the Health curriculum framework. This includes the collection and review of materials to be made available to educators to use in implementing the curriculum frameworks.

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The professional learning opportunities and resources developed through this process allow for counties and districts:


- to address their local needs for State Priority 2 and LCAP alignment
