ESSA Background

The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)

- Signed into law by President Obama
December 2015
- Reauthorization of the federal
Elementary and Secondary Education
Act (ESEA)
- Replaces the No Child Left Behind Act
- Purpose: to ensure educational equity
and opportunity for disadvantaged and
high-needs students
- Supplements state programs



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California ESSA State Plan Timeline

April 12, 2018	Additional State Board of Education (SBE) meeting
July 12, 2018	U.S. Department of Education (ED) approved California's Consolidated ESSA State Plan (State Plan)
August 2018	SBE Information Memorandum: ESSA Implementation
October 5, 2018	ESSA Stakeholder meeting
October 18, 2018	Local Control Funding Formula Stakeholder meeting
November 2, 2018	ESSA Stakeholder meeting
January 2019	SBE agenda item regarding implementation

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Waiver Request

California requested a four-year waiver from ED to allow California to include recently reclassified fluent English proficient (RFEP) students measuring the progress of English learners (ELs) to achieve English language proficiency and provide additional weight for long-term English learners (LTEs).



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Waiver Request Timeline

April 12, 2018	SBE directed CDE to request waiver from ED
May 16, 2018	CDE submitted waiver request to ED
October 9, 2018	California received “initial determination of denial” letter
October 17, 2018	California resubmitted waiver request

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ELPI and School Identification

- Transition to English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC)
- 2019: ELPI Status available on Dashboard

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Proposed Revisions

1. Include language clarifying that California will report Status in 2019
2. Modify timeline for identification of Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) and Additional Targeted Support and Improvement (ATSI) schools



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Other Proposed Amendments

- Update to reflect incorporation of the Participation Rate into the calculation of the Academic Indicator
- Revisions to reflect the evolution and additional details regarding the System of Support
- Other typographical corrections
