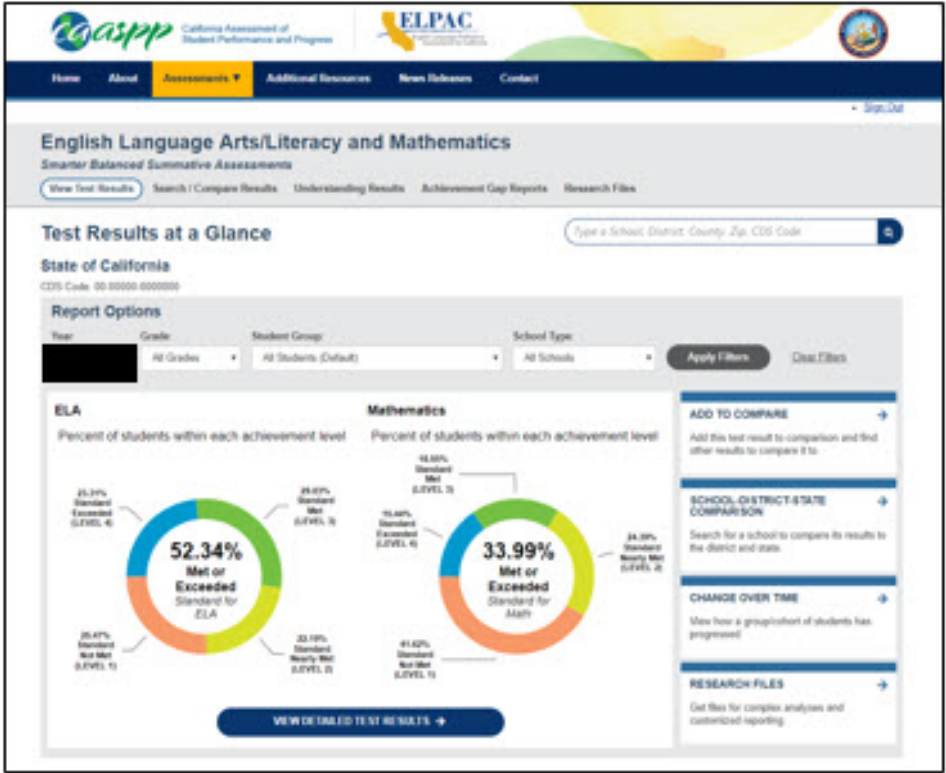
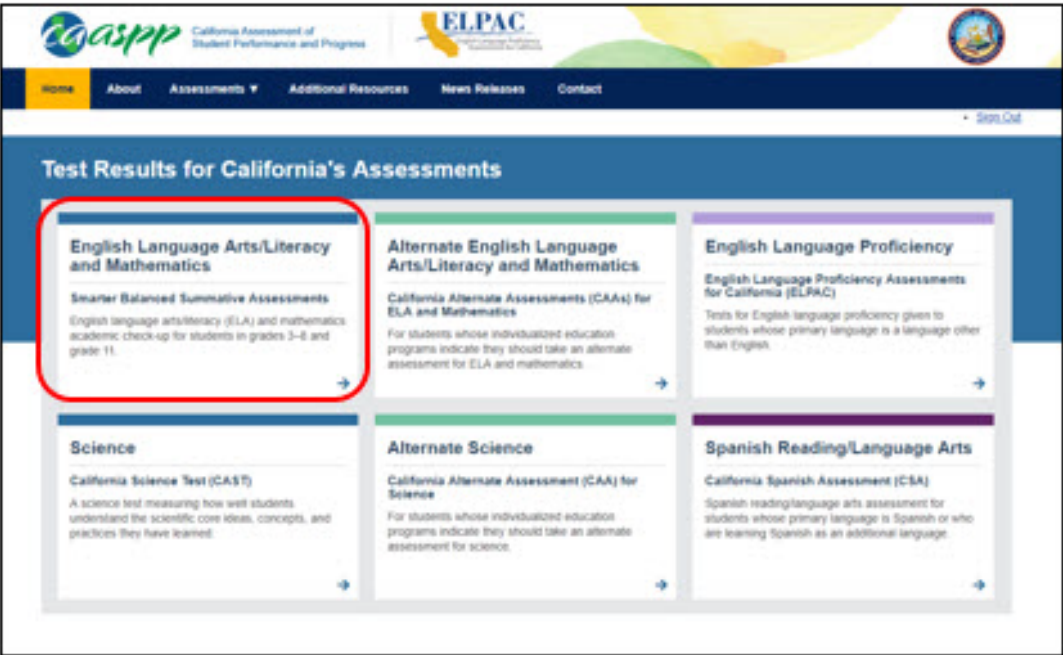
Spanish Reading/Language Arts

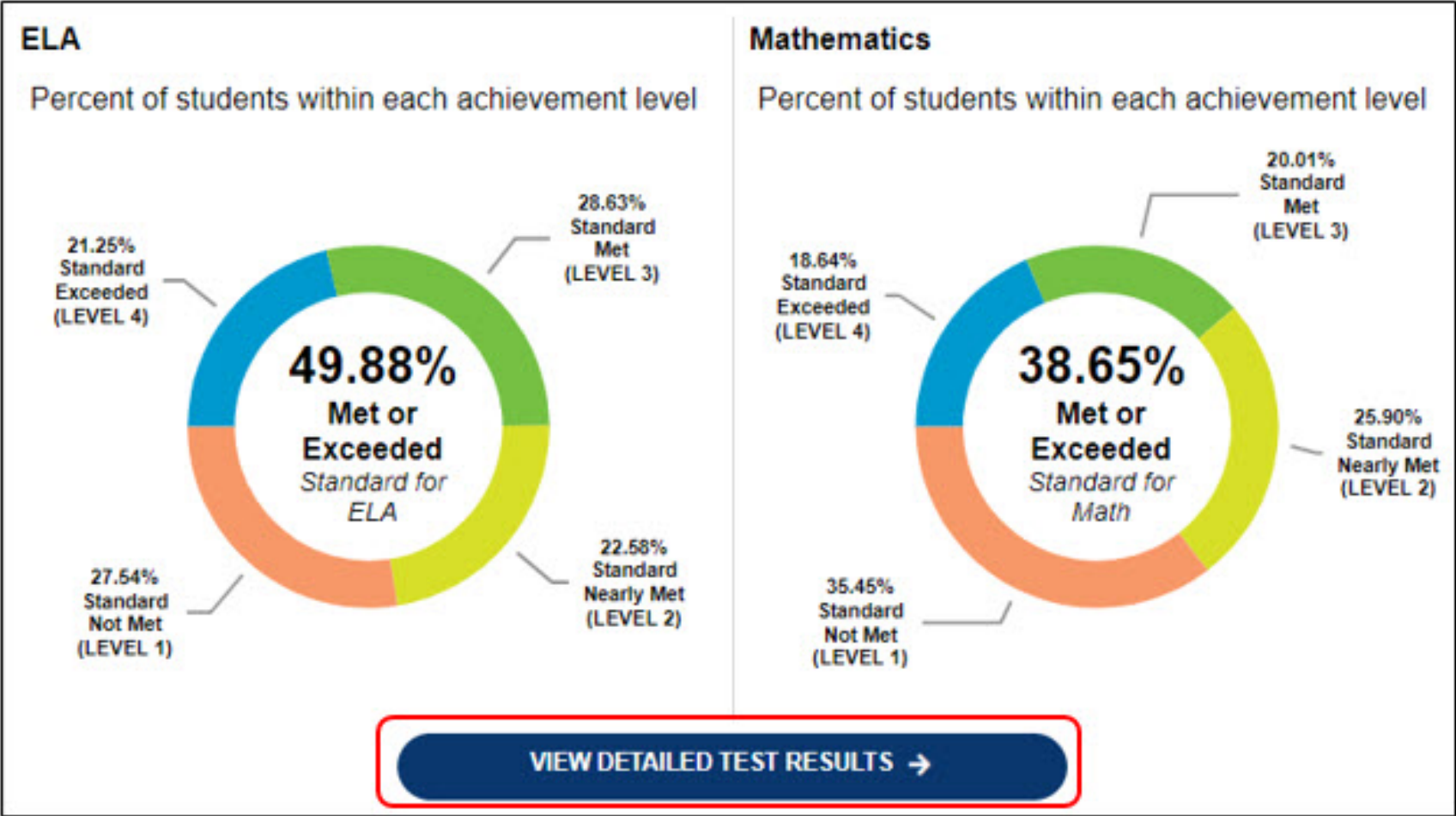

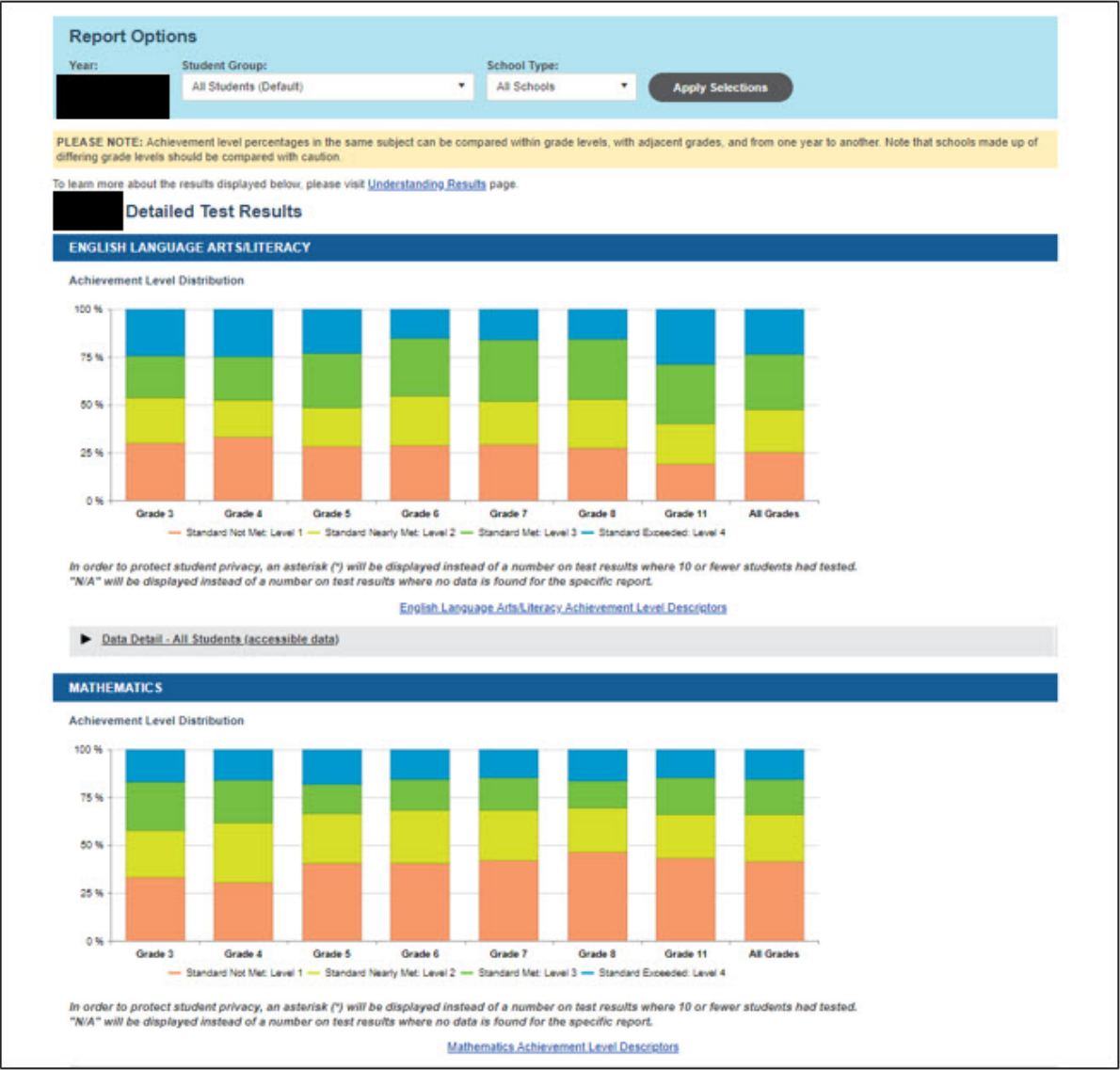

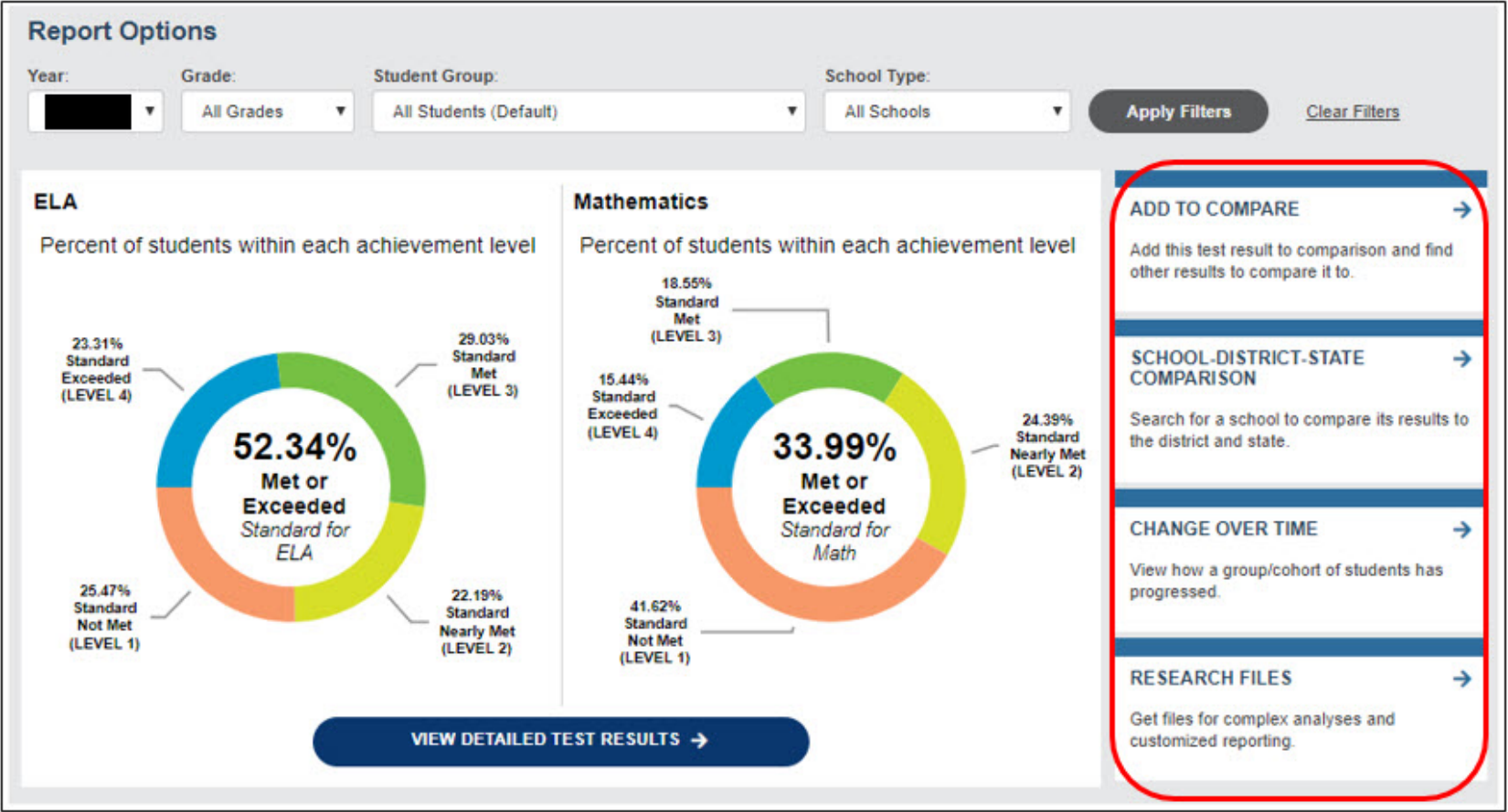
