Of the \$642,535 in Reserves, \$238,082 is in the form of Fixed Assets (Buildings, Land, and Equipment). Of the remaining \$404,453, \$50,000 was intended to be used for Economic Uncertainties and \$200,000 for Facilities Acquisition and Capital Projects. This was confirmed subsequently by our Board of Directors on January 10, 2023 when they designated \$50,000 for Economic Uncertainties and \$200,000 for Facilities Acquisition and Capital Projects. So the schools plan for reserves is summarized as follows: \$238,082 Fixed Assets \$50,000 for Economic Uncertainties \$200,000 for Capital Projects \$154,453 Unassigned/Unappropriated Reserves
