1. Explain why the charter school did not meet the criteria for the funding level requested. Include specific measures or actions taken by the charter school to comply.

Kings Canyon Online did not meet the criteria for the funding level requested. In the 21/22 school year, we projected a significant increase in enrollment as a result of the COVID 19 pandemic. During the 21/22 school year, we served nearly 260 students, double our typical enrollment in the program. As a result, we received quite a bit of additional ADA funding. In addition, KC Online received a significant amount of COVID relief funding. As an online independent study program, we found it challenging to spend all of those extra funds when students primarily work from home. In effort to expend 70% or more of our funds, we purchased devices and bags for every student in the program, should they need them. We updated computer monitors in our computer lab for students that come into the site to work. We also hired additional teachers to ensure a low teacher to student ratio and adequate student support and a on site administrator to support students, parents, and teachers.

2. List and explain the mitigating circumstance(s) to be considered by the CDE and ACCS.

As mentioned in section 1, KC Online experienced a significant increase in enrollment due to the COVID 19 pandemic and parent fear of in person instruction immediately following. In addition, KC Online received a significant amount of COVID relief funding. As an online independent study program, we found it challenging to spend all of those extra funds when students primarily work from home. During a typical year, we would have more student in our physical computer lab. Again, due to COVID concerns, our daily "student in seats" count was much lower last year than in a typical school year.

KC Online is projected to meet expenditure requirements for 80% funding in future years with the addition of additional staff which will be an ongoing cost as well as program expansion which will also be an ongoing annual cost (curriculum licensing and personnel).
