South Bay Charter School received a significant increase in LCFF funding for the 2021-22 school year as a result of higher enrollment and also because of pandemic related adjustments to the LCFF calculations. Total revenue exceeded projections from our 2nd Interim budget by 17%. Additional instructional aides were hired as the year progressed, but those expenses ramped up later than anticipated. Projected instructional and related costs for the 2022-23 school year are projected to be close to those expenses in 2021-22 even though total enrollment and total revenue has decreased significantly.

- 2. List and explain the mitigating circumstance(s) to be considered by the CDE and ACCS.
- 1) Pandemic revenue adjustments created a difficult environment for budgeting, particularly with a surge of unanticipated funding late in the year.
- 2) The district is projected to spend well over 70% of current year (2022-23) revenue on instruction and related services, partly because we have maintained some of the increased staffing that we were able to hire late last year and partly because our total revenue is reduced significantly.
