Due to one time grants/COVID-19 funding and prior years hold harmless adjustments/deferrals received in 21-22 (which is explained below) our school was \$467,000 short in instruction expenditures from hitting above the 80% funding determination criteria.

Specific measures and actions our school has taken to meet our criteria is membership/contracting with Charter Schools Development Center CSDC who is a leader in understanding nonclassoom-based charter school finance. Our schools CBO is working directly with CSDC's CBO to insure we meet the criteria for the funding level requested.

2. List and explain the mitigating circumstance(s) to be considered by the CDE and ACCS.

In 21-22 our school received \$216,606 in one time grants/COVID-19 funding. The revenue is restricted and majority had carryover expenditures to the next school year 22-23. \$80,808 of the \$216,606 was to be expended between 21-22 through 25-26.

Our School also received \$256,727 in prior years adjustments/deferrals from years 18-19 through 20-21. The total amount of 21-22 one time grants/COVID-19 funding and prior years adjustments/deferrals is \$473,333.

At the end of the 21-22 school year FP Charter Administration and the Governing Board ratified salary negotiations with FP Charter CTA. In Sept 2022 increases for all Certificated and Classified staff (except Executive Director and Principal) received a 7% increase effective 22-23 school year. The total cost of this increase is \$438,187.

FP Charter Admin will be negotiating with the FP Charter CTA again this school year 22-23 regarding negotiating another salary increase amongst stipends for our one time funding grants received for future added instruction and professional development.
