We have been fundend over the past three years at 85% even though we qualified for 100%. We need to be funded at 100% for us to be able to obtain a proper facility for our program and for us to meet the needs of our students, while also ensuring that we stay within the proper student to teacher ratio. The Guajome Learning Centers supports students who are the most at risk of not finishing high school. The GLC support students who are struggling with physical and mental health issues, are at risk of becoming credit deficient, have become pregnant, are having social struggles in the classroom setting, or are working to help support their families. The additional funding will ensure that we are able to provide a facility and educational program that fully supports these students.
