The Fresno County Superintendent of Schools (FCSS) submits the attached annual academic performance report as part of the oversight agreement between the California State Board of Education and the FCSS. This report was prepared by Jeffrey Hunt, Ed.D, Director of Charter Schools at the office of the FCSS, with data compiled by the charter school.

KECSD produced and adopted an LCAP for the 2025-2026 school year during the 2024-25 school year. Based on the charter renewal petition site visit and evaluation results, and a review of the dashboard and statewide data, FCSS has no concerns with the charter district. The FCSS team performed a site visit at Kingsburg Elementary on October 24, 2025.

The FCSS provides the same support to KECSD as it does for other districts and charters in the county. This includes but may not be limited to: LCAP training, coaching, and approval; state & federal program support, financial oversight and support; curriculum, instruction, and assessment support, and CALPADS technical support.
