Overview

The California Department of Education (CDE) has released the 2024–25 Annual Reclassified Fluent English Proficient (RFEP) Rates downloadable data file, which reports counts of English Learner (EL) and RFEP students and the corresponding Annual RFEP Rates.

Where is this downloadable file available?

The 2024–25 Annual RFEP Rates downloadable data file is available on the CDE web site linked in the QR code at the bottom of this flyer.

How is the RFEP rate calculated?

The rate is calculated by dividing all reclassified (RFEP) students (numerator) by the total number of ELs (denominator) for an academic year (July 1 to June 30).

Calculation of School A's RFEP rate:

$$\frac{\text{2 Reclassified ELs}^{*1}}{\text{5 Total ELs}^{*2}} = 40\% \text{ RFEP Rate}$$

*1 Submitted by local educational agencies as part of the California Longitudinal Pupil Achievement Data System (CALPADS) End-of-Year data collection.

Students are included in the numerator of the school site where they were *last enrolled as ELs* and reclassified during an academic year (July 1 to June 30).

*2 All ELs are included at the entity in which they were *last enrolled* during an academic year (July 1 to June 30).
