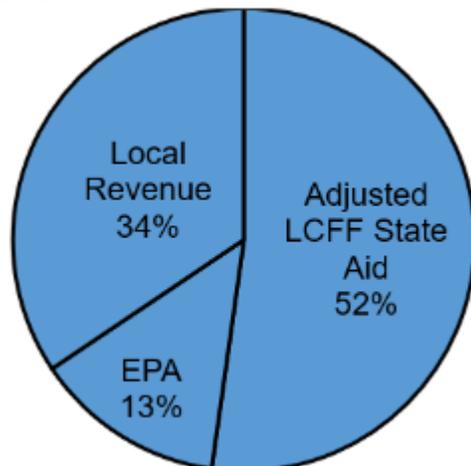

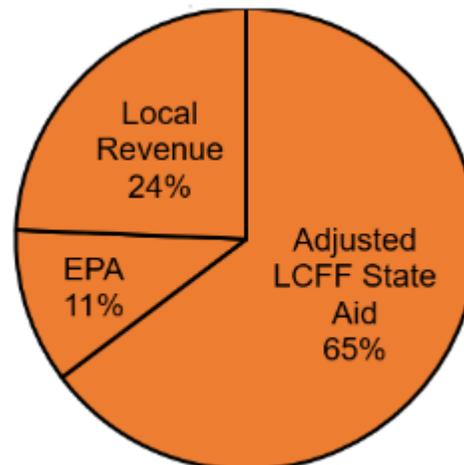

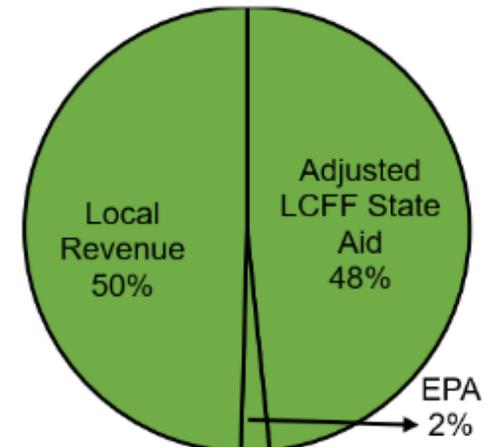
School District Funding

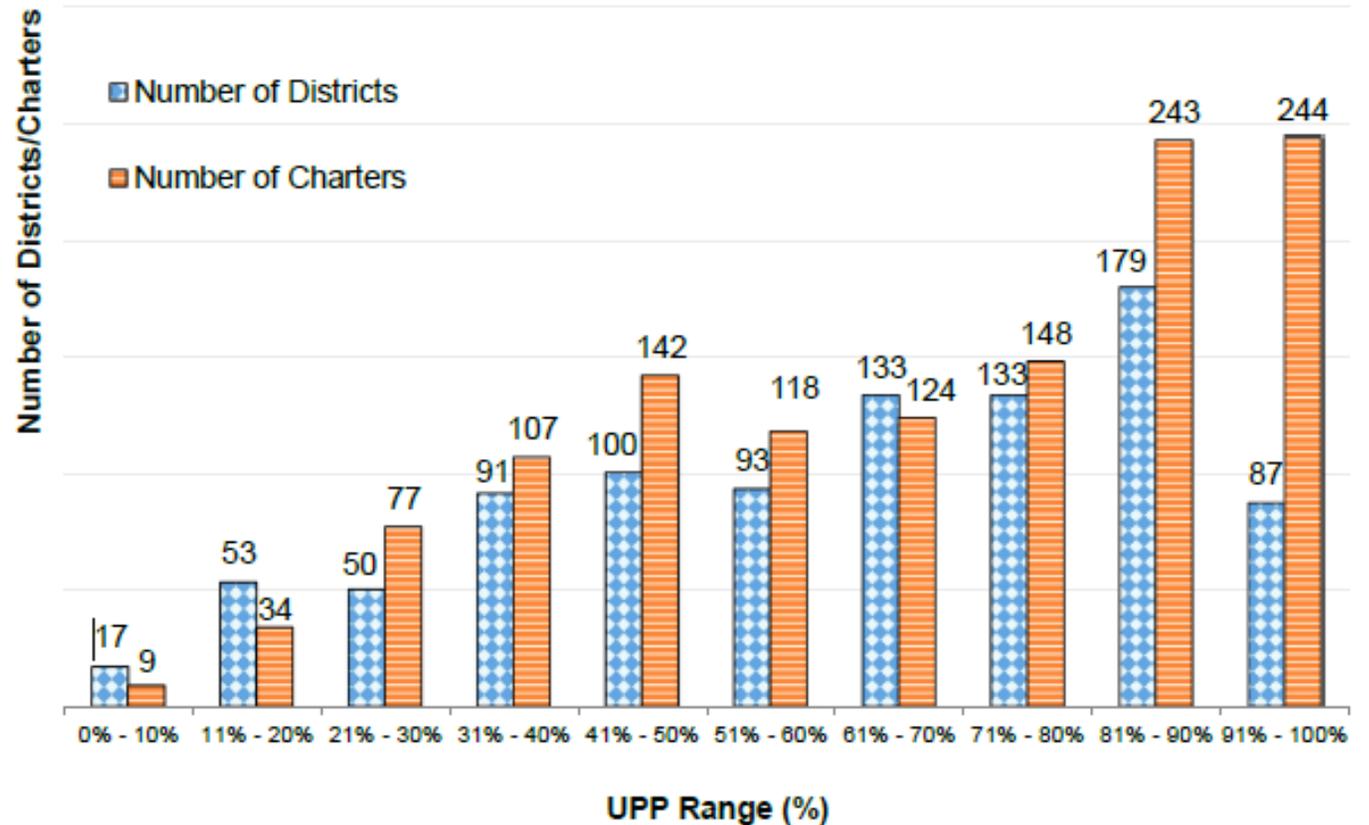
