Budget Act of 2016 (SB 826)

- On or before March 1, 2017, the California Department of Education (CDE) shall develop a new quality funding expenditure plan for submission as an amendment to the state's Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG) State Plan





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QRIS Requirement

- The new quality expenditure plan shall prioritize activities that support the Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS)
- It is the intent of the Legislature that, to the greatest extent possible, the state use funding from the state's CCDBG quality allocation to support the QRIS





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Continued Funding and Compliance

- The new quality expenditure plan shall maintain funding for resource and referral agencies, local planning councils, and licensing enforcement
- The new quality expenditure plan shall comply with the federal CCDBG Act of 2014





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
Draft Due Date

- On or before February 1, 2017, the CDE shall provide a draft of the new quality expenditure plan to the Department of Finance and the Chairperson of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee for review and comment

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CCDBG re: QRIS

- Enhance a tiered QRIS, which may support and assess the quality of child care providers in the State





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CCDBG re: QRIS

- Enhance a tiered QRIS, which may build on State licensing standards





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CCDBG re: QRIS

- Enhance a tiered QRIS, which may be designed to improve the quality of different types of child care providers and services



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- Enhance a tiered QRIS, which may describe the safety of child care facilities



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CCDBG re: QRIS

- Enhance a tiered QRIS, which may build the capacity to promote parents' & families' understanding of CA's early childhood system and the ratings of the programs in which the child is enrolled



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CCDBG re: QRIS

- Enhance a tiered QRIS, which may provide, to the maximum extent practicable, financial incentives & other supports designed to expand the full diversity of child care options and help child care providers improve the quality of services



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CCDBG re: QRIS

- Enhance the QRIS, which may accommodate a variety of distinctive approaches to ECE & care, including:
 - Those practiced in faith-based settings, community-based settings, child-centered settings, or similar settings that offer a distinctive approach to early childhood development
