



# College/Career Indicator

On the California School Dashboard (Dashboard), districts and schools that serve students in grade twelve receive the College/Career Indicator (CCI). This indicator looks at how well local educational agencies and schools are preparing graduates for college and/or career. Graduates who meet specific CCI “prepared” criteria are included in the calculations of the CCI rate.

## CCI Reported as Status Only

For the 2023 Dashboard, the CCI will report the most current year data or “Status only”. Therefore, the CCI will have performance displayed using one of five Status levels that range between Very Low (lowest performance), Low, Medium, High, and Very High (highest performance) as illustrated below.



## Calculating Current Year Data Only

Status for the 2023 CCI will be calculated as follows:



Number of students who graduated “Prepared”

Divided by

Total number of students in the 2022–23 combined four- and five-year graduation rate

Equals

CCI rate\*

\* The CCI rate is used to determine the Status level (i.e., Very High to Very Low) for this indicator.

## Colors to Return in 2024

Next year, for the 2024 Dashboard, Change (or the difference from prior year) and Performance Levels (or colors) will be calculated since there will be two consecutive years of CCI data.
