California School Dashboard

A new website that shows how local educational agencies and schools are performing on test scores, graduation rates, and other measures of student success.

Local Educational Agencies (LEAs)

- **School districts**
- **County Offices of Education (COE)**
- **Charter schools**
 - The accountability system has certain differences for charter schools

Note: Alternate indicators are in development for schools included in the Alternative Schools Accountability Model (ASAM)

Dashboard Features

Easy to use reports: The Dashboard includes reports showing LEA or school performance on:

- 6 state indicators
- 4 local indicators (6 for county offices of education).

LEA/school search: Users can view reports that present the performance data in different ways.

State Indicators

The state indicators are based on data that is collected consistently across the state from LEAs.

The state indicators are:

- Academic Indicator [English language arts and math]
- English Learner Progress
- Chronic Absenteeism
- Graduation Rates
- Suspension Rates
- College/Career Readiness

State Indicators

LEAs and schools receive one of **five color-coded performance levels** on the state indicators.

From highest to lowest, the five performance levels are: Blue, Green, Yellow, Orange, Red.

Performance Levels:  Blue (Highest)  Green  Yellow  Orange  Red (Lowest)

The overall performance level that LEAs and schools receive is based on how current performance (Status) compares to past performance (Change).

This recognizes improvement as part of overall performance.

Local Indicators

Data is not collected at the state level in some areas covered by the new accountability system.

The Dashboard includes local indicators for these areas:

- Basic Services
- Implementation of State Academic Standards
- Parent Engagement
- School Climate
- Coordination of Services for Expelled Youth (county offices of education only)
- Coordination of Services for Foster Youth (county offices of education only)

Local Indicators

The Dashboard shows ratings on the local indicators based on whether LEAs measure and publicly report their progress using locally collected data:

- Met
- Not Met
- Not Met for Two or More Years.

For LEAs with a “Met” rating, the local data that they collected on that indicator will be included in one of the Dashboard’s Detailed Reports.

Local indicators **do not** apply to individual schools.

It also shows the total number of student groups that received a performance level for each indicator and how many of those student groups are in the two lowest performance levels (Red/Orange). The total number of student groups may vary due to the number of grade levels included within each indicator.

Performance Levels: Blue (Highest) Green Yellow Orange Red (Lowest)

An asterisk (*) shows that the student group has less than 11 students and is not reported for privacy reasons. The performance level (color) is not included when there are less than 30 students in any year used to calculate status and change. An N/A means that data is not currently available.

Optional Narrative Summary

A narrative text box will be provided as an optional feature for local educational agencies to describe their performance on the state and local indicators. This option will be included in the Dashboard Coordinator Portal to be completed by LEAs. The optional narrative will be displayed as text summary paragraph at the bottom each report to provide additional context and information.

Selecting Dashboard Reports

Users can choose from four different reports by selecting tabs underneath the demographic information included at the top of the web page.



Users can also see additional information about an indicator or student group by selecting that indicator or student group.

Dashboard Reports

Equity Report:

- Shows overall performance and information about student group performance

Status and Change Report:

- Shows overall performance and the Status and Change for state indicators

Single Indicator Reports:

- Shows overall performance and student group performance on a single state indicator

Single Student Group Reports:

- Shows performance of a single student group on the state indicators

Dashboard Reports

Detailed Reports:

- Show year-by-year data for the state indicators and additional state data that is relevant to the state indicators. For LEAs, they will also show the locally collected data reported on the local indicators.
- Will be added as a new feature in April 2017.


Student Group Report:

- Show the performance of all students and each student group on the state indicators.




