


How to View Performance of a School or District on the 2022 Dashboard

- 1. The California School Dashboard can be accessed at https://www.caschooldashboard.org/.
- 2. To view the results for a school or district, type the school or district name into the search bar.



3. Once you select a school, its overall performance on state measures will be displayed. If you select a district, its overall performance on both state and local measures will be displayed. Local indicators are only available for districts, county offices of education, and charter schools.



4. Below the performance overview, you will find information about the student population.




- 5. At the bottom of the page, you will find more detailed information on each state and local measure. The state and local measures are organized into three areas: Academic Performance, Academic Engagement, and Conditions & Climate. In the sample data card provided to the right, the school received a High performance level for the Graduation Rate Indicator because in the current year, 90.6 percent of the students graduated, thus placing the school at a High performance level. At the bottom of each data card is an Equity Report. This report prominently displays the number of student groups placed in each performance level for that measure. This equity report to the right shows that two student groups received a Status of Very Low, none of the student groups received a Status of Low, nine student groups received a Status of Medium, one student
- Select the View More Details button below the Equity Report for detailed information on how student groups performed on that indicator.
