The College/Career measure shows how well local educational agencies (LEAs) and schools are preparing students for likely success after graduation. Graduates classified as Approaching Prepared on this state measure must meet *at least one* of the criteria in the Approaching Prepared level.

One semester, two quarters, or two trimesters of college coursework with a grade of C- or better in academic/Career Technical Education subjects where college credits are awarded 3

Career Technical Education (CTE) Pathway

Pathway completion with a grade of C- or better in the capstone course 5

University of California (UC) and California State University (CSU) a-g requirements

Complete a–g course requirements with a grade of C- or better
