

How to View Change Over Time for Test Results

The Change Over Time report displays information from year to year so counties, districts, or schools can view information about improvement.

- 1 Navigate to <https://caaspp-elpac.cde.ca.gov/>.
- 2 Select the **English Language Arts/Literacy and Mathematics** tile.
- 3 Search for an entity by entering a School, District, County, ZIP, or CDS Code.
- 4 Select the **Change Over Time** tile located in the navigation bar to the right of the results you are viewing.
- 5 Select an end year from the **End Year** drop-down menu.
- 6 Select a grade from the **Grade** drop-down menu.

View how a group/cohort of students has progressed.

- i** Only grade levels where testing takes place in the prior grade level will appear in this menu. Grade three is not an available option because students in grade two are not tested, so there is no previous year with which to compare. Grade eleven is not an option because students are tested only once in high school, so there is no previous year with which to compare.

- 7 Select a student group from the **Student Group** drop-down menu (optional).

- 8 Select the **Apply Selections** button.
