1 Navigate to <https://caaspp-elpac.cde.ca.gov/>.

2 Select the **English Language Arts/Literacy and Mathematics** tile.

3 Search for an entity by entering a School, District, County, ZIP, or CDS Code.




*The report defaults to data for all students for the current year unless the organization closed in a previous year, in which case the report defaults to the last year the organization was open.*

*Graphs are available that show the percentage of students within each achievement level for both English language arts/literacy (ELA) and mathematics. The number shown inside each graph represents the combined percentage of students in the Standard Met and Standard Exceeded achievement levels.*



4 Select the **View Detailed Test Results** button.

*Bar charts that show the percentage of students in each of the four performance levels, by grade, are available for both ELA and mathematics. Hovering over any area of the bar chart will display the percentage of students in that level.*



5 Select the triangle to expand **Data Detail** for detailed information.



*Data Detail includes the following:*

*Overall Achievement: Includes the number of students enrolled, tested, and with scores; the mean scale score; and the percentage of students in each performance level.*

*Areas: Includes the percentage of students in the three levels for each claim area.*

6 Select the **Achievement Level Descriptors** link, below the bar chart, to view information about the achievement level descriptors. Select the **Scale Score Ranges** link, below the **Data Detail** table, to view scale score ranges for each subject.

*Hovering over the information icon next to each row label will display additional information about the data in that row.*
