The LEA is a first year independent Charter School. AJJCS was asked to complete the NCB Form, but it was established as a classroom based school program TK-8, with independent study for grades 9-12 as those grades are added. In 2020-21, AJJCS serves only TK-8 and the only distance learners are due to COVID. In 2021-22, AJJCS will add 14 9th graders as Independent Study. No Independent Study will be allowed for TK-8, only virtual learning for students with special circumstances due to COVID as done in 2020-21. Due to COVID, AJJCS is doing a hybrid program. Currently, AJJCS does have 19.4% of our students doing full distance learning. AJJCS is completing this form out of an abundance of caution in case the percentage of NCB students increases due to the uncertainty of COVID. AJJCS does not intend to increase the the 20% of students doing nonclassroom based.
