As the current fiscal year began last July 1, our budget anticipated a very substantial improvement in enrollment and attendance as a result of the availability of the COVID-19 vaccines and the dramatic decline in COVID infections. Contrary to expectations, however, the disruptions caused by the pandemics have persisted and, in some respects, even worsened this year. Enrollment and attendance have so far been significantly lower than anticipated in our budget; and it is expected that our ADA-based revenue will be significantly less than budgeted.
