ACE is a non-classroom-based charter school that is facing transportation issues in 2021-22. ACE's bus contractor has not been able to provide buses to the school this year due to a shortage of bus drivers. As a result, a large population of students has been forced into independent study until the school can find transportation for them. ACE expects to have some buses available some time in October 2021, which should prevent the school from having more than 20% of its ADA come from independent study. However, the school is choosing to file this funding determination in the unlikely event that the transportation issue persists for a longer period of time.
