Also, the district currently utilizes two portable classrooms located on the Hanford Adult School site for Hanford Online Charter. Eventually the district would like Hanford Online Charter to have it's own location. District administration does not think that 5% or \$50,000 is sufficient to have on hand for a down payment should the opportunity for a new building become available.

1. Explain why the charter school did not meet the criteria for the funding level requested. Include specific measures or actions taken by the charter school to comply.

Hanford Online Charter did not meet the criteria using 21/22 unaudited actuals for the 100% funding level requested. The Charter grew from 21 ADA to 115 ADA during the pandemic and District administration were very concerned with the volatility of ADA and hold harmless funding from pre-pandemic figures and didn't anticipate to be fully funded from the P2 ADA that came to fruition in 2022. Administration was very conservative in budgeting and didn't want to increase expenses in Fund 0900 at the same rate that ADA grew. If the charter wasn't funded at the 115 ADA from P2, expenses could not be sustained without a contribution. Our conservative methodology resulted in underspending for the 21/22 school year in Fund 0900.

2. List and explain the mitigating circumstance(s) to be considered by the CDE and ACCS.

Coming out of the Covid-19 pandemic in the 21/22 school year there were many factors and unknown details in regards to charter funding and hold-harmless ADA that resulted in underspending in Fund 0900. The district was able to still address learning loss, provide integrated pupil supports and addressed health and safety concerns using one-time pandemic funding. The district originally anticipated a larger number of students returning to traditional schooling but enrollment and attendance for Hanford Online Charter has maintained steady coming out of the pandemic so the district has become more comfortable making multi year projections based on P1 and P2 estimated ADA.

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3. Provide any other pertinent information that may assist the CDE and ACCS in conducting a detailed review or develop a reasonable basis for a recommendation.

For the 22/23 school year the charter has increased many services including counseling services from .6 FTE to a 1 FTE; increased 1.5 FTE in certificated/instructional staffing; increased .5 FTE in classified attendance support; added a Student Specialist for 1 FTE and we have started looking for an additional .5 FTE for additional certificated/instructional staffing for the 23/24 school year.
